SHAWL GOOD

We used earthy, natural colors to give our shawl a southwestern style. But if you'd prefer something a little flashier, don't be afraid to mix and match brighter colors instead. Psst... The chevron pattern (zig-zag designs) gives the shawl an extra layer of complexity and pop!



Measurements: Approx. 56 x 32"

Materials:

- I Love This Yarn™, 7 oz (199 g) skeins of 355 yds (325 m):
 - Ivory (A) - 1 skein
 - Burnt Pumpkin (B) - 2 skeins
 - Sea Blue (C) - 2 skeins
 - Sungold (D) - 1 skein
- US size 1/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle

Gauge: 8 dc sts and 5 rows = 2 ½"

Size: One Size

Instructions:

With A, ch 4, sl st to first ch to make ring.

Row 1: Ch 2, 3 dc in ring, ch 2, 4 dc in ring, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, dc in same st, 1 dc on each next st across row, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) corner in ch sp, 1 dc on each next st across row, 2 dc in same last st, turn.

Rows 3-5: Rep row 2, turn.

Row 6: *1 sc in next st, ch 5, sk 3, rep from * until corner, (1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) corner in ch sp, *ch 5, sk 3, 1 sc in next st, rep from * until end of row, turn.

Row 7: Ch 2, *(4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc) in ch sp, rep from * until corner, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) corner in ch sp, *(4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc) in ch sp, rep from * until end of row, 1 dc in last st, turn.

Row 8: Ch 2, dc in same st, ch 3, *1 sc in next ch sp, ch 4, rep from * until last ch sp before center, ch 3, (1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) corner in ch sp, ch 3, 1 sc in next ch sp, *ch 4, 1 sc in ch sp, rep from * until last ch sp before end of row, ch 3, 2 dc in same last st, turn.

Row 9: Ch 2, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc in next st, 3 dc in next ch sp, 1 dc in next st, *4 dc in next ch sp, 1 dc in next st, rep from * until ch sp before last ch sp, 3 dc in next ch sp, 1 dc in next st, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) corner in ch sp, 1 dc in next st, 3 dc in next ch sp, *1 dc in next st, 4 dc in next ch sp, rep from * until ch sp before last ch sp, 1 dc in next st, 3 dc in next ch sp, 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in same last st, turn.

Row 10: Rep row 2, turn.

Row 11: Ch 2, dc in same st with A, *with D, 1 dc in next 2 sts, with A, 1 dc in next 2 sts, rep from * until corner, with A (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch sp. After corner, work colors symmetrically. End with 2 dc in same last st, turn.

Rows 12-13: Rep row 2, turn.

Rows 14-18: Rep rows 6-10, turn.

Row 19: Join B. Rep row 2, switching A and B on each dc until end of row. Cut and weave in A.

Rows 20-21: Continuing with B only, rep row 2, turn.

Rows 22-26: Rep rows 6-10, turn.

Row 27: Ch 2, dc in same st with B. *with D, 1 dc in next 2 sts, with B, 1 dc in next 2 sts, rep from * until corner, with B (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch sp. After corner, work colors symmetrically. End with 2 dc in same last st, turn.

Rows 28-29: Rep row 2, turn.

Rows 30-34: Rep rows 6-10, turn.

Row 35: Join C. Rep row 2, switching B and C on each dc until end of row. Cut and weave in B.

Rows 36-37: Continuing with C only, rep row 2, turn.

Rows 38-43: Rep rows 6-10, turn.

Row 44: Rep row 2, turn.

Row 45: Join D. Rep row 2, switching C and D every 2 dc until end of row. Cut and weave in D, turn.

Row 46: Continuing with C only, rep row 2. Cut yarn and weave in ends.



THAT'S A WRAP

This crocheted lovely is more than just a scarf—it doubles as a shawl! Drape it across your shoulders for a cuddly top layer. Or fashion it around your neck for a sophisticated look.



CROCHET HOORAY

Don't settle for just any scarf—create something that's going to turn heads! The pom-poms and puff stitch clusters on this fashion-forward creation keep it looking fun and give it a one-of-a-kind feel.

SCARF / easy

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
dc = double crochet
dc cl = double crochet cluster
dc2tog = double crochet
2 stitches together
dc3tog = double crochet
3 stitches together

hk = hook
lp(s) = loop(s)
rep = repeat
sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slipstitch
sp = space
st(s) = stitch(es)
yo = yarn over

Measurements: Approx. 64 x 17 ½"

Materials:

- I Love This Yarn™, 7 oz (199 g) skeins of 355 yds (325 m):
 - Glacier (A) – 2 skeins
 - Sungold (B) – 1 skein
 - Sea Blue (C) – 1 skein
- US size 1/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook

Gauge: 8 dc sts and 5 rows = 2 ½"

Special Stitches:

Double crochet cluster (dc cl): *yo, insert hk in same st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through 2 lps, rep from * 5 times, yo, pull through all 5 lps, ch 1.

Instructions: (scarf continued)

With A, ch 4.

Row 1: 3 dc in third ch from hk, turn.

Row 2: Sc in each next st across row, turn. Use these instructions for all pair rows throughout.

Row 3: Ch 2, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc on each next st across row, turn.

Row 5: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 7: Ch 2, 2 dc in same st, 1 dc in each next st across row, turn.

Row 9: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 11: Ch 2, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Row 13: Rep row 7, turn.

Rows 15-19: Rep rows 3-7, turn.

Row 21: Ch 2, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Row 23: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 25: Rep row 7, turn.

Rows 27-29: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 31: Ch 2, 2 dc in same st, 1 dc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Rows 33-37: Rep rows 3-7, turn.

Row 39: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 41: Ch 2, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Row 43: Rep row 7, turn.

Rows 45-48: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 49: Rep row 7, turn.

Row 51: Ch 2, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc in next 3 sts, *ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, rep from * 2 times, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Row 53: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 55: Rep row 7, turn.

Rows 57-59: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 61: Ch 2, 2 dc in same st, 1 dc in next 2 sts, *ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, rep from * 2 times, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Rows 63-65: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 67: Rep row 7, turn.

Row 69: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 71: Ch 2, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc in next 2 sts, *ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, rep from * 3 times, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Row 73: Rep row 7, turn.

Rows 75-77: Rep row 3, turn.

Row 79: Rep row 7, turn.

Row 81: Ch 2, 2 dc in same st, 1 dc in next 2 sts, *ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, rep from * 3 times, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Rows 83-85: (Ch 2 is first dc) Dc3tog, 1 dc in each next st across row, turn.

Rows 87-89: (Ch 2 is first dc) Dc2tog, 1 dc in each next st across row, turn.

Row 91: (Ch 2 is first dc) Dc3tog, 1 dc in next 3 sts, *ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, rep from * 3 times, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Rows 93-95: Rep row 87, turn.

Row 97: Rep row 83, turn.

Row 99: Rep row 87, turn.

Row 101: (Ch 2 is first dc) Dc3tog, 1 dc in next 3 sts, *ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, rep from * 2 times, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Rows 103-111: Rep rows 93-101, turn.

Rows 113-119: Rep rows 93-99, turn.

Row 121: (Ch 2 is first dc) Dc3tog, 1 dc in next 3 sts, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in next 13 sts, ch 1, sk 1, 1 dc in each next st to end of row, turn.

Rows 123-151: Rep rows 103-121, turn.

Rows 153-159: Rep row 87, turn.

Row 161: Rep row 83, turn. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

Finishing:

With B, dc cl on each skipped st. With A, make one row of sc all around piece. With B, make one row of sc all around piece. With C, make one row of sc all around piece. With C, make two pompons.
