WEDDING WELCOME

We used a heat tool to make holes along the bottom of this welcome sign (it comes gorgeously lettered!) and tied on cotton fringe with lark's head knots. Then we painted on bright flowers and dipped the fringe into a mix of acrylic paint and water for that darling dip-dyed look.



Tip: Not comfortable with hand-lettering? You can print out your menu, place it under the acrylic plaque, and trace it.



^ AU MENU

Class up your reception with DIY menu plaques! We hand-lettered the menu onto an acrylic sheet with a paint marker and then placed a silk leaf behind the words. To finish: Place another acrylic sheet behind the leaf (secure with adhesive dots) and hide the edges with copper tape.

∨ POWER COUPLE

Make sure everyone at the reception knows who you are! These clear bride and groom signs (complete with ribbon ties) are a cinch to customize. For a look like ours, just apply acrylic paint to the back of the signs to make the white words pop.





< IN THE SPOTLIGHT

A paint marker and glitter cardstock turn an ordinary acrylic box into a wow-worthy centerpiece! Simply trace your seating info onto the box with a paint marker and then secure a cut-to-size piece of cardstock to the bottom—and fill with pre-made bouquets!

GIFTING GOLD >

No special technique here—but the results are extraordinary! To make: Paint metal leaf adhesive on the back of our pre-made “Cards and Gifts” sign and let it dry slightly (aim for tacky). Then apply gold leaf over the adhesive. And voila!

From the cover: We placed floral scrapbook paper behind a pre-lettered “reserved” sign and traced the design with a paint marker.





^ I PROMISE YOU

Writing your own vows? Turn them into a keepsake! We printed these vows on transparency sheets and adhered them to acrylic sheets with double-sided tape. A few gemstone stickers hide the tape and turn your promises into a one-of-a-kind memento.

^ CARD DUTY

A blank acrylic box is the perfect canvas for gorgeous gold-leaf. Simply place your designs behind the acrylic... then trace away. Line the box with glitter scrapbook paper for an extra touch of ooh-la-la.

^ SET THE TABLE

Get wedding china that's budget-friendly—and completely customized to your reception design! You can paint a transparent acrylic charger to match any decor scheme. Enjoy the oohs and aahs!
Tip: Keep the charger food-safe by only painting on the back.





FAIRYTALE ENDING

The right cake topper is a wedding game-changer! For one like ours: Engrave your lettering onto an acrylic sheet (a template behind the sheet is your best friend here) and spray the back with frosted-glass spray paint. Then cover the back with cardstock and gold foil the edges.



GUEST-ING GAME

This guestbook sign started out as a clear acrylic piece with simple white lettering. We gave it an etched effect by placing a vinyl wreath sticker (DIY'd with a die-cut machine) on the back and applying frosted-glass spray paint. When we removed the sticker, the design was revealed!

WITH THIS RING

This clear acrylic ring box is the perfect canvas for personalization—hello, keepsake! We used an engraving tool to etch the happy couple's initials on the lid (using a pre-printed design as a template). Then we tucked some moss and a dainty wooden heart inside.



TABLE FOR TWO >

Mimic the look of frosted glass with spray paint on an acrylic table sign (it comes with its own wooden base!). A gold number sticker directs your guests to the right reception tables and floral stems (attached with hot glue) add a touch of green. It's a piece of (wedding) cake!

YOU'RE INVITED >

Create a special token of love to remember your nuptials. Print your invitation onto vellum and use double-sided tape to adhere it to the back of an acrylic sheet. Then add gold leaf around the edges (and don't forget a matching bow).
