





High-density foam before embellishing.

First apply primer.

Then dry-brush with dark paint. Let dry.

Paint over with lighter color, keeping paint blotchy and cloudy for weathered look.



WEATHERING

Dry-brush dark and light paints over one another to create a weathered look. Psst... Leave edges darker and add imperfections to create realistic dimension.

Splotchy shading around the corners and edges enhances the weathered aesthetic.










STEP 4

Be sure to leave some slack in the straps-you'll need to create gaps for holding.








- 1. Air-dry foam clay.
- 2. Roll clay into ball.
- 3. Flatten with roller.
- 4. Remove cured resin gem from mold.
- 5. Lightly press gem into flattened clay. Use craft knife to cut edge around gem.
- 6. Let clay harden, then sand edges of gemstone casting until smooth. Adhere casting to foam crown with rubber cement (this adhesive only sticks to itself, so it must be applied to both the casting and the crown).








SHAPING

When foam is heated, it can be molded and manipulated into desired shapes-like these rounded shoulder pads. Heat also allows the foam to bend without cracking.



TEXTURING

Add an extra level of detail to foam projects by creating textures. Use a rotary tool for deep, intricate features or a heated foil ball for minor impressions.





The fins and earpieces were textured with clay shaping tools.






STEP 1

Punch holes into cuff and tab. Apply rubber cement to both pieces (this adhesive only sticks to itself, so it must be applied to each piece of foam).

STEP 2

Adhere tab, making sure holes on cuff line up.
Thread ribbon for laces.








- 1. Heat pellets following package instructions (pellets turn clear when heated and return to white when cool).
- 2. Press snowflake die-cut into surface of heated pellets.
- 3. Let pellets cool somewhat, allowing them to become solid but still soft enough to cut (taffy-like consistency is ideal). Cut around die-cut with craft knife. Remove die-cut and sand edges.
- 4. When snowflake is completely cool, paint and embellish as desired.

Snow Shoe Template Guide

• For a full size template, cut out all pieces. Align arrow ends and tape template together. • Size fits youth 8-10 years old. • Scale to desired size. TOE **x2** Trim based on the shape of the shoe *Snowflake made from moldable pellets and diecut.



ADDITIONAL TIPS:



Adding hook-and-loop straps to the sides of the armor makes it adjustable! Reinforce the straps with foam tabs (see strapping technique).



We connected the visor to the helmet with long fasteners (find them in Scrapbook & Paper Crafts). The brads become hinges, allowing the visor to easily pivot up and down.



Use braided elastic to create stretchy, comfortable shoulder straps. Just knot the elastic into loops and feed it through a slit in the foam (see template).
