HOBBY LOBBY®

These beauties don't have stems, but you can improvise by mounting a single flower on a dowel rod.



Pliable petals are a detail-lover's dream come true. Fiddle with them until they're perfect, and they'll hold the shape.

BRIGHT IDEA

This candle holder looks like it has a porcelain base—but look again! We painted the edges of a 4-inch foam flower with gold liquid leaf and then nestled a votive candle holder inside it.



MIX IT UP

For an on-trend but timeless look, combine white flowers with clusters of mixed greenery. Use eucalyptus and wispy stems to create dramatic shape and drape.



LOVE BLOOMS

Velvety white foam flowers are the centerpiece of these DIY wedding projects. Available in a variety of sizes (up to 18 inches!), these versatile blossoms can help you transform your wedding into a romantic dreamscape.

BONUS: They're self-adhesive!





Quick trick: You can anchor these blooms to a foam-topped cake board by attaching them to wired floral picks.



These flowers are flat on the back, so they're great for freestyle arrangements! No foam, wire or glue required.

Versatility? Yes, please! Dress the flowers down (hello, rustic cheesecloth!) or glam them up with satin ribbon and glossy greens.



GRACEFUL GREETINGS

Use foam flowers to play up the design of this reception-ready sign. After stapling a laurel leaf garland (embellished with berry stems and cheesecloth ribbon) to the edges, peel the adhesive backing from the blooms to secure them to the sign.



FLOWER POWER

Celebrate your big day with gorgeous 18-inch blooms. **Stems:** dowels (we glued two together for length) wrapped in strips of painted linen. **Leaves:** craft wire (to hold the shape) sandwiched between two linen leaf shapes.



BIG PICTURE

Oversized flowers set the stage for celebration! Attach a cascade of white blossoms and assorted leaves to the corners of an oversized frame. *TIP: Use a foam block base for arrangements and then secure them to the frame with floral wire.*
