HOBBY LOBBY®

LOVABLE LLAMA

Say olé! to the sweet southwestern style of this little llama! We used post stitches to give the cactus realistic ridges and touchable texture.

Skill Level:

Intermediate

Gauge:

- US size I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook: 10 sts and 11 rows = 3"
- US size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook: 10 sts and 11 rows = 2"

beg = begin(ning)
bpsc = back post single crochet
ch = chain
dc = double crochet
dc2tog = double crochet 2 together
hdc = half double crochet
hk = hook
pm = place marker

Materials:

- Baby Bee® Sweet Delight®, 4 oz (115 g) skeins of 377 yds (345 m):
 - Sand Castle (A) – 1 skein
 - Naked (B) – 1 skein
 - Surf Baby (C) – 1 skein
 - Sunkisses (D) – 1 skein
 - Pink-A-Boo (E) – 1 skein
 - Teal, Too! (F) – 1 skein
 - Toy Elephant (G) – 1 skein
 - Baby Sage (H) – 1 skein
 - Pooltime (I) – 1 skein
 - Bashfull (J) – 1 skein
- US size I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook
- US size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stuffing
- Place marker
- Pompom maker
- 2 eyes



Finished Measurements:

Llama: Approx. 8" tall x 6" (nose to tail) x 3" side to side of body, 3.5" side to side of head (measurements are with stuffing inserted)

Hat: Approx. 5" top to bottom (lying flat without braids and pom pom) x 5" front to back

Poncho: Approx. 4.75" long x 2.75" wide without tassels

Cactus: Approx. 4" tall x 1.5" wide (filled with stuffing and no flower)

Instructions:

Llama [Use double yarn strand and US size 1/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook.]

Legs (make 4)

With A, ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

Row 1: 4 sc into ring, pm.

Row 2: *2 sc in each next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Rows 3-6: 1 sc in next 8 sts, pm.

Cut yarn and put legs aside.

Body

Center Piece (CP)

With A, ch 4. Sc in second ch from hk and each st across. Legs will be attached in next row around 4 sides of this piece.

Row 7: Sc in short side of CP, join a leg, making 1 sc on next 8 sts around it, 1 sc on next 3 sts of CP, join a leg, making 1 sc on next 8 sts around it, 1 sc on next st of CP, join a leg, making 1 sc on next 8 sts around it, 1 sc on next 3 sts of CP, join a leg, making 1 sc on next 8 sts around it, pm.

Rows 8-18: 1 sc in next 40 sts, pm.

Row 19: 1 sc in next 15 sts, sc2tog, 1 sc in next st, sc2tog, 1 sc in next st, sc2tog, 1 sc in next st, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 14 sts, pm.

Row 20: 1 sc in next 15 sts, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 14 sts, pm.

Row 21: 1 sc in next 15 sts, sc2tog, 1 sc in next st, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 14 sts, pm.

Row 22: 1 sc in next 8 sts, sk 17 sts, 1 sc in next 7 sts, pm.

Row 23: 1 sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 6 sts, pm.

Rows 24-29: 1 sc in next 14 sts, pm.

Cut yarn.

Head

With A, ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

Row 1: 6 sc into ring, pm.

Row 2: *2 sc in each next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 3: *1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 4: *1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 5: *1 sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 6: *1 sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Rows 7-12: 1 sc in each next st all around, pm.

Row 13: *1 sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 14: *1 sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 15: *1 sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 16: *1 sc in next st, sc2tog, rep from * all around, pm.

Cut yarn.

Nose

With B, ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

Row 1: 7 sc into ring, pm.



Row 2: *2 sc in each next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 3: *1 sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Rows 4-5: 1 sc in next 16 sts, pm.

Cut yarn.

Ears

With A, ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

Row 1: 4 sc into ring, pm.

Row 2: *2 sc in each next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Rows 3-7: 1 sc in next 8 sts, pm.
Cut yarn.

Tail

With A, ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

Row 1: 3 sc into ring, pm.

Row 2: 4 sc all around, pm.

Cut yarn.

Finishing Llama:

Embroider mouth to nose. Sew stuffed nose and ears to head. Add eyes. Sew back of llama and tail. Add stuffing to llama's body and head. Sew head to body.

Poncho [Use single yarn strand and US size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook. Switch between st 1 and st 2 every time you turn, beg in row 2.]

St 1: 1 sc in each st across row, turn.

St 2: *1 sc in next st, 1 sc, inserting hk in next st of previous row, rep from * all across row, turn.

With C, ch 12, turn.

Row 1: 1 sc in second ch from hk and each st across row, turn.

Row 2: With E, st 1.

Row 3: With F, st 2.

Row 4: With D, st 1.

Row 5: With E, st 2.

Row 6: With C, st 1.

Row 7: With D, st 2.

Row 8: With F, st 1.

Row 9: With C, st 2.

Rep rows 2-9 until poncho measures 4.5".
With C, make a row of sc all around piece.

Finishing Poncho:

With C, make 14 tassels 1" long.

Attach tassels to poncho's ends.

Hat [Use single yarn strand and US size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook. Switch between D and C on each row.]

St 1: 1 sc in each st around row, sl st to first sc.

St 2: *1 sc in next st, 1 sc, inserting hk in next st of previous row, rep from * all around row, sl st to first sc.

With D, ch 7.

Row 1: 16 dc into ring, sl st to first dc.

Row 2: With C, *2 dc in next same st, 1 dc in next st, rep from * all around row, sl st to first dc.

Row 3: With D, st 1.

Row 4: With C, st 1.

Row 5: With D, st 2.

Row 6: With C, *2 dc in next same st, 1 dc in next st, rep from * all around row, sl st to first dc.

Row 7: With D, *2 dc in next same st, 1 dc in next 2 sts, rep from * 4 times, ch 3, sk 2 sts, 1 dc in next 8 sts, *2 dc in each next same st, 1 dc in next 2 sts, rep from * 4 times, sl st to first dc.

Row 8: With C, st 1.

Row 9: With D, st 1.

Row 10: With C, st 2.

Row 11: With D, 1 dc in each next st all around row, sl st to first dc.

Row 12: With C, 1 dc in each next st all around row, sl st to first dc.

(The next rows are to make the flaps of the hat.)

Row 13: With D, 1 sc in next 15 sts, turn.

Row 14: With C, 1 sc in next 9 sts, turn.

Row 15: With D, sc2tog, st 2 until 2 sts are left, sc2tog in last sts, turn.

Row 16: With C, dc2tog, 1 dc in next 5 sts, dc2tog, turn.

Row 17: With D, dc2tog, 1 dc in next 3 sts, dc2tog, turn.

Cut and weave in ends.

Go to beg of row 13 and work in opposite direction, repeating rows 13-17 to make second flap.

Finishing Hat:

With D and C, make 2 rows of sc all around hat. With C, make 2 small braids 1.5" long. Attach them to last row of flaps. With C, make small pompom and add it to top of hat.

Cactus [Use single yarn strand and US size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook. Switch between H and I every two rows.]

With H, ch 15, turn.

Row 1: 1 sc in second ch from hk and each st across row, turn.

Row 2: 1 bpsc in each st across row, turn.

Rows 3-4: With I, 1 bpsc in each st across row, turn.

Rows 5-6: With H, 1 bpsc in each st across row, turn.

Rows 7-16: Rep rows 3-6.

Cactus Arm

With H, ch 7, turn.

Row 1: 1 sc in second ch from hk and each st across row, turn.

Row 2: 1 bpsc in each st across row, turn.

Rows 3-4: With I, 1 bpsc in each st across row, turn.

Cut yarn and sew sides together. Bend in half and sew to main cactus.

Pot

With G, ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

Row 1: 7 sc into ring, pm.

Row 2: *2 sc in each next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Row 3: *1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next same st, rep from * all around, pm.

Rows 4-11: 1 sc in next 21 sts, pm. Cut yarn.

Flower

With J, ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

Row 1: *1 sc into ring, ch 2, rep from * 5 times, sl st to first sc.

Row 2: *5 hdc in ch sp, sl st in next st, rep from * 5 times.

Cut yarn.

Finishing Cactus

Sew cactus edges and close one end. Fold $\frac{1}{4}$ " of pot to outside. Fill cactus and pot with stuffing. Sew flower to cactus's closed end. Sew cactus to pot.

Finishing Llama (as a whole):

Put hat on llama's head. Sew poncho to back of llama. Sew pot on back of llama close to tail. Make two small pompoms with D. Make one small pompom with E and F. Place them between cactus and llama's neck.



Darling Dragon

Darling details make this dragon pattern irresistible. Stitch two layers together for sturdy wings and use bubble stitches to make the peaks on the crown.



Skill Level: Easy

Gauge:

- 18 sts and 21 rows = 4" square

Abbreviations:

blo = back loop only
BO = bind off
ch = chain
dc = double crochet
dc cl = double crochet cluster
dec = decrease
flo = front loop only
hdc = half double crochet
hk = hook
inc = increase
lp(s) = loop(s)
rep = repeat
sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slipstitch
sp = space
st(s) = stitch(es)
tc cl = triple crochet cluster
tog = together
yo = yarn over

Materials:

- Baby Bee® Sweet Delight®, 3.5 oz (115 g) skeins of 377 yds (345 m):
 - Baby's Blue (A) – 2 skeins
 - Pooltime (B) – 2 skeins
 - Cloudy (C) – 1 skein
- Yarn Bee® Soft and Sleek™, 5 oz (142 g) skeins of 232 yds (213 m):
 - Mustard (D) – 1 skein
- US size F (3.75 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stuffing
- Stitch markers
- 2 eyes

Special Stitches:

Invisible Decrease: Pick up flo onto crochet hk of the 2 sts you want to crochet tog, yo and pull through, now you have 1 sc instead of 2.

Double Crochet Cluster (dc cl): *yo, insert hk in same st, yo, pull through 2 sts, * 3 times, yo, pull through all 4 lps.

Triple Crochet Cluster (tc cl): *yo, insert hk in same st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through 2 lps, rep from * 4 times, yo, pull through all 5 lps.

Notes:

- Crochet with 2 strands of yarn, unless otherwise noted.
- In amigurumi, you don't connect each row back—instead, you just continue working in a sort of spiral. Use stitch markers to keep track of where your rows end/begin. Follow this rule for all pieces, unless otherwise noted.
- On increase/decrease rows, spread these out in each row so that the gradual increase/decrease of the piece is smooth (ex: if you inc at st 5 on the first row, you increase at st 15 on the next, 25 the next, etc.).
- Total number of sts is listed in parentheses at the end of each rnd/row.

Head

With A:

Rnd 1: 8 sc into a magic ring (8).

Rnd 2: Sc around, inc in every other st (12).

Rnd 3: Sc around, inc in every other st (18).

Rnd 4: Sc around, inc in every third st (24).

Rnd 5: Sc around, inc in every third st (32).

Rnd 6: Sc around, inc in every fourth st (40).

Rnd 7: Sc around, inc in every fourth st (50).

Rnds 8-13: Sc around (50).

Rnds 14-28: Sc around, 1 dec in each row (49-35).



Rnd 29: Sc around, dec every sixth sc (30).

Rnd 30: Sc around, dec every fifth sc (25).

Rnd 31: Sc around, dec every fourth sc (20).

Rnd 32: Sc around, dec every third sc (15).

Rnd 33: Sc around, dec every other sc (10).

Cut yarn, leaving 12" tail. Stuff head, place eyes, then use tail to gather last 10 sts and close. Weave in tails to finish.

Nostrils

Decide where you want nostril's center to be (it'll be a sp between two sc), move 2 sc to right and sl st around that sc, then 4 sc around row behind sl st in center sp you found, then sl st back around second sc to left of center.

Tie off and weave in ends. *Rep for second nostril.

Body

With A:

Starting with legs and working up:

Rnd 1: 6 sc into magic ring (6).

Rnd 2: Sc around, inc in every st around (12).

Rnd 3: Sc around, inc in every other st (18).

Rnd 4: Sc around, inc in every third st (24).

Rnd 5: Sc around, inc in every fourth st (30).

Rnds 6-13: Sc around (30).

Tie off, leaving tail to weave in later. Rep rnds 1-13 for second foot, but do not tie off or cut.

Rnd 14: Now you'll join the legs, using yarn still attached to second leg to sc around first leg, then around second leg (60).

Rnds 15-24: Sc around (60).

Rnds 25-35: Sc around, 2 dec in each row (58-38).

Rnds 36-50: Sc around, 1 dec in each row (37-23).

Tie off and leave 1-yard tail to use to attach head. Stuff body, then st head to body.

Tie off and weave in the ends.

Tail

With A:

Rnd 1: 6 sc into a magic ring (6).

Rnds 2-17: Sc around, 1 inc in each rnd (7-22).

Rnds 18-27: Sc around, 2 inc in each rnd (24-42).

Rnds 28-30: Sc around, 3 inc in each rnd (45-51).

Tie off, partially stuff tail, start stitching tail to back of body, then finish stuffing before fully attaching tail. Tie off and weave in ends.

Arms

With C:

Rnd 1: 6 sc into magic ring, sl st to join, ch 1 (6).

Rnd 2: Sc around, inc in every st, sl st to join, ch 1 (12).

Rnd 3: Sc around, inc every other st, sl st to join, tie off, weave in ends (18). (Switch to color A.)

Rnd 4: Sl st to attach to rnd 3, sc around (18).

Rnds 5-23: Sc around (8).

BO, leave 18" tail, stuff arm. Hold top edges together and whipstitch, then st to body. Tie off and weave in ends. Rep for second arm.

Belly

With C:

All sc in rows 2-21 in blo.

Row 1: Ch 7, sc in second ch from hk, then crochet across (6).

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in last st (8).

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in last st (10).

Rows 4-5: Ch 1, turn, sc across (10).

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in last st (12).

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in last st (14).

Rows 8-15: Ch 1, turn, sc across (14).

Rows 16-20: Ch 1, turn, dec, sc in next 10 sts, dec (12-4).

Row 21: Ch 1, turn, crochet tog the only 2 sts (1).

Tie off, leaving 1-yard tail, use tail to st this piece onto belly, tie off and weave in ends.

Spikes

With B:

Rnd 1: 4 sc in magic ring (4).

Rnds 2-7: Sc around, 2 inc in each rnd (6-16).

Tie off, leaving 18" tail. Rep to make 6 spikes total, then use tails from each spike to stitch down the head, back, and tail, tie off and weave in all ends.

Wings

With B:

Row 1: Ch 14, sc into second ch from hk, then sc in next 12 sts (13).

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 12 sts (14).

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc across (14).

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 13 sts (15).

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc across (15).

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 14 sts (16).

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc across (16).

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 15 sts (17).

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc across (17).

Row 10: Ch 4, 1 dc in first st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts, *1 hdc, (1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc) in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts*. Rep from * to *.

Tie off and weave in ends. Rep to make 4 wings total. St 2 wings together so that they're thicker and able to stand out on their own, then rep

for other 2 wings. St wings to back of dragon on either side, between arm and spikes row, tie off and weave in ends.

Crown

With D:

Ch 30, sl st to make a ring.

Row 1: 30 sc all around ring. Sl st to first sc.

Row 2: *1 sc in each next 9 sts, 2 sc in same st, rep from * all around. Sl st to first sc.

Row 3: *1 sc in each next 10 sts, 2 sc in same st, rep from * all around. Sl st to first sc.

Row 4: 1 sc in each next st all around. Sl st to first sc.

Row 5: *1 sc, ch 2, sk 1 st, dc cl in next st, ch 2, sk 1 st, rep from * 4 times, 1 sc, sk 1 st, ch 3, tc cl, ch 3, sk 1 st, *1 sc, ch 2, sk 1 st, dc cl in next st, ch 2, sk 1 st, rep from * 4 times, 1 sc. Sl st to first sc.

Row 6: 1 sc, *2 sc in ch sp, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in same st, 2 sc in ch sp, sk 1 st, rep from * 4 times, 3 sc in ch sp, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in same st, 3 sc in ch sp, sk 1 st, *2 sc in ch sp, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in same st, 2 sc in ch sp, sk 1 st, rep from * 4 times, 1 sc. Sl st to first sc.

Cut and weave in ends.



KOALA CUTIE

We upped the cuteness quotient of our koala pattern with a eucalyptus stem and flower.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Gauge: 18 sts and 18 rows = 4" square (double strand)

Abbreviations:

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

dec = decrease

hdc = half double crochet

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

sc = single crochet

sl st = slipstitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

Measurements:

Approx. 8" tall

Materials:

- Baby Bee® Sweet Delight®, 4 oz (115 g) skeins of 377 yds (345 m):
 - Flannel (A) - 2 skeins
 - Pink-A-Boo (B) - 2 skeins
 - Toy Elephant (C) - 1 skein
 - Baby Sage (D) - 1 skein
 - Chocolate (E) - 1 skein
- Baby Bee® Baby Lou Lou™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 267 yds (244 m):
 - Ivory (F) - 1 skein
- US size I (5.5 mm) crochet hook
- US size G (4.25 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- 2 eyes (15 mm)
- 2 wood buttons (16 mm)

Tip: The more stuffing you use, the more stable your koala will be!



Instructions: (Koala continued)

All pieces are made with 2 strands of yarn unless noted otherwise.

Ears: (make 2 of each)

Rnds are worked continuously. Place st marker at beg of each rnd.

Outer ear:

With A, make a magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ch 1.

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around.

Rnd 2: 1 sc in first st, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 3: 1 sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 4: 1 sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 5: Sc in each st around. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Inner ear:

With F, make a magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ch 1.

Rnds 1-3: Rep outer ear rnds 1-2. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Sew inner ear pieces inside outer ear pieces.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Nose:

With C, ch 9.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch and next 6 chs, 4 sc in last ch (now working in bottom of foundation ch, sc in next 6 chs, 2 sc in last).

Rnds 2-3: 1 sc in each st around. Sl st to join to beg. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Head:

Rnds are worked continuously. Place st marker at beg of each rnd.

With A, make a magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ch 1.

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around.

Rnd 2: 1 sc in first st, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 3: 1 sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 4: 1 sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 5: 1 sc in first 4 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 6: 1 sc in first 5 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 7: 1 sc in first 6 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 8: 1 sc in first 7 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnd 9: 1 sc in first 8 sts, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnds 10-14: 1 sc in each st around.

Rnd 15: 1 sc in first 8 sts, dec 1, rep around.

Rnd 16: 1 sc in first 7 sts, dec 1, rep around.

Rnd 17: 1 sc in first 6 sts, dec 1, rep around.

Rnd 18: 1 sc in first 5 sts, dec 1, rep around.

Rnd 19: 1 sc in first 4 sts, dec 1, rep around.

Rnd 20: 1 sc in first 3 sts, dec 1, rep around.

Rnd 21: 1 sc in first 2 sts, dec 1, rep around.

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing to body. This will be the bottom of your head that will connect with the body. You should have 18 sts.

Begin stuffing head. Sew nose onto front of head. Place eyes on either side of nose, about 2 sts over from edge of nose.

Finish stuffing head. Sew on ears.

Main Body/Legs:

Rnds are worked continuously. Place st marker at beg of each rnd.

With A, make a magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ch 1.

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around.

Rnd 2: 1 sc in first st, 2 sc in next, rep around.

Rnds 3-12: 1 sc in each st around.

Fasten off. This is your first leg. Rep for second leg, do not fasten off.

Rnd 1: Ch 3, attach to first leg. Sc around first leg, across ch 3 and around second leg to beg.

Rnds 2-16: 1 sc in each st around.

Rnd 17: 1 sc in first 5 sts, 1 dec, rep around.

Rnd 18: 1 sc in first 4 sts, 1 dec, rep around.

Rnd 19: 1 sc in first 3 sts, 1 dec, rep around.

Rnd 20: 1 sc in first 2 sts, 1 dec, rep around.

Stuff body and attach head to top of body.

Arms (make 2):

With A, make a magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ch 1.

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around.

Rnds 2-3: 1 sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: Sc in first 4 sts, 1 dec, rep.

Rnds 5-14: 1 sc in each st around.

Stuff arms and sc ends closed.
Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing. Attach arms to sides of body.

Overalls

With B, ch 37, join ends tog to form a circle, ch 1.

Rnd 1: Hdc in each st around, sl st to join to beg st, ch 1, turn.

Rnds 2-5: Hdc in each st around, sl st to join to beg, ch 1, turn.

Rnd 6: Sl st over 1 st, hdc in next 16 sts, sl st to join to beg sl st, ch 1.

Rnd 7: Hdc in each st around, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

Rnd 8: 3 hdc in each st around, sl st to join to beg, fasten off.

Join yarn 2 sts over from first sl st you made when starting first leg.

Rnd 1: 1 hdc in 16 sts, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

Rnd 2: 1 hdc in each st around, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

Rnd 3: 3 hdc in each st around, sl st to join to beg, fasten off.

Sew opening between leg holes closed.

Find 10 front center sts of overalls, join yarn at one end.

Row 1: Ch 1, hdc in each of 10 sts, ch 1, turn.

Rows 2-5: 1 hdc in each st, ch 1, turn. Fasten off after row 5.

Straps (make 2)

With B (leave long tail for sewing), ch 21, sc in each ch across, ch 1 turn. 3 hdc in each st across. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Attach one end of straps to back of overalls. Crisscross and attach other ends to front bib. Attach buttons.

Flower

With B (1 strand, hk size G), make a magic ring, 6 sc in ring, sl st to join to beg. Ch 2, (3 dc, ch 1, sl st) all in first st (sc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1, sl st) in each of next 5 sts, fasten off.

Leaves (make 5)

With D (1 strand, hk size G), ch 6. Sl st to join to second ch from hk, sc in next st, hdc in next, dc in next, 7 dc in next (now working on bottom of foundation ch), dc in next, hdc in next, sc in next, sl st to join to beg, fasten off.

Attach flower and leaves to ear.

Stick

With E (1 strand, hk size G), ch 4, sl st to join to beg, sc around 9 times. Ch 6, sc in each ch back down. Ch 8, sc in each ch back down. Attach leaves to stick. Attach stick to hand.
