Mixed Pompom

Bow-making is a breeze with wired edge ribbon. It's easy to handle and looks great too!

Double Loop
Here's a bow that's doubly delightful...literally! And the animal print keeps it on the wild side.



Rosettes

Turn wired edge ribbon into rose-like accents—just ruffle and spiral the ribbon.



Sunburst

Crinkling long pieces of ribbon gives modern bows a vintage look.



Burlap & Lace

Two words: rustic radiance! Lacy burlap creates a look of natural sophistication.



Classic Pompoms

We tied these loops together with twine. It's a fashionable way to keep bows secure!



Satin & Sheer

Pair satin and sheer ribbon for stylishly shiny bows!



Metal Bow

Put the petal to the metal! Give bouquets a modern upgrade with embossed metal ribbon.



Stamped Ribbon

The big loops and long tails on this bow make it the perfect canvas for stamped phrases.

Rural Ribbon

Mix and match ribbons for one-of-a-kind bows! This farmhouse-inspired flower arrangement combines three pastoral looks—buffalo check, denim and a floral pattern—for a countrified creation!



Stripe Hype

It's time to earn your stripes as a bow-making master! This twist on the classic two-loop bow doesn't settle for just two tails, but four! The simple enhancement breathes new life into both fresh and faux floral arrangements.



Pointed-Loop Bow

Supplies:

- Wired edge ribbon
- Hot glue
- Scissors

Step 1

Lay ribbon right side down. Bring ends around and flatten to create pointed loops. Glue to secure.

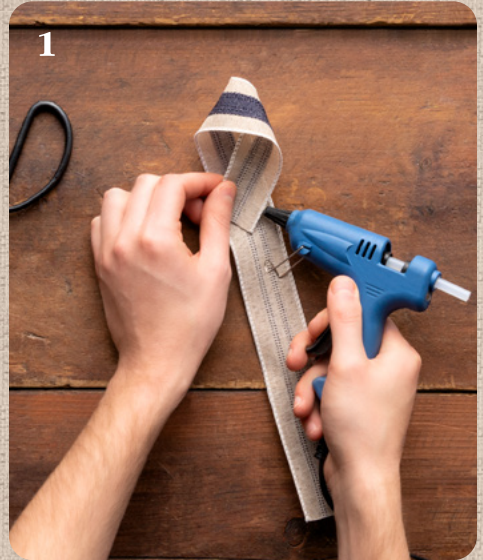
Step 2

Wrap center of bow with additional ribbon, add tails, and glue all pieces to secure.

Mixed Pompom Bow

Supplies

- Canvas & gold weave wired edge ribbon
- Light gold wired edge sheer ribbon
- Scissors

Step 1

Layer ribbon. In one hand, make 10 loops (five on each side). Use your thumb to keep loops bunched together.

Step 2

Tie center of loops together with another piece of ribbon, creating bow shape.

Step 3

Cut sheer ribbon loops, then dovetail ends.

Step 4

Arrange remaining intact loops into pompom shape and add canvas ribbon tails.



Stamped Ribbon

Supplies

- Glitter wired edge ribbon
- Canvas wired edge ribbon
- Rubber stamps
- Ink pad
- Hot glue
- Scissors

Step 1

Stamp ribbon as desired.

Step 2

Make two-loop bow and pair with additional bow.

Step 3

To layer both bows, wrap a piece of ribbon around center of bows and hot glue to secure.



Double-Loop Bow

Supplies

- Leopard print ribbon
- Black jute
- Scissors

Step 1

Make four loops (two on each side), then tie center of loops with jute to secure shape.

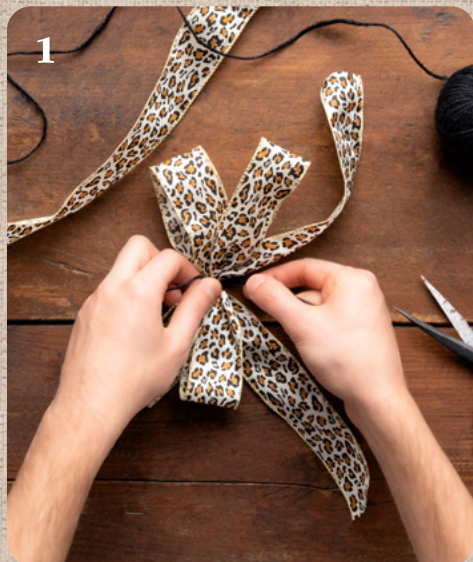
Step 2

Wrap center of bow with another piece of ribbon, knotting it in place.

Burlap & Lace Bow

Supplies

- Lace & burlap ribbon
- Jute
- Scissors

Step 1

Gather four pieces of ribbon and scrunch in center.

Step 2

Tie ribbon pieces together with jute.

Satin & Sheer Bow

Supplies:

- Satin ribbon
- Sheer ribbon
- Scissors

Step 1

Gather as many ribbon pieces as desired and tie them together with additional piece of satin ribbon.

Step 2

Cut ends into dovetails and fan out to add volume.

Rosettes

Supplies

- Wired edge ribbons
- Hot glue
- Scissors

Step 1

Ruffle ribbon by pulling on one end of wired edge.

Step 2

Create rose-like spiral and hot glue back of ribbon to secure shape.

Step 3

Embellish rosettes with mini bows and ribbon leaves.



Classic Pompom Bow

Supplies

- Wired edge ribbon
- Twine
- Scissors

Step 1

Form 12 loops (six on each side), using your thumb to keep loops bunched together.

Step 2

Tie twine around center of bow, then fan out loops to form pompom shape.

Step 3

Cut dovetail ends.



Metal Bow

Supplies

- Embossed metal ribbon
- Hot glue
- Scissors

Step 1

Create two loops (make one slightly smaller) and glue ends to secure.

Step 2

Glue loops together (smaller loop on top for layered look). Wrap center and add tails.



Sunburst Bow

Supplies

- Three styles/widths of ribbon
- Hot glue
- Scissors

Step 1

Crinkle ribbon to create vintage look if desired.

Step 2

Form and layer loops (secure with hot glue) to create largest layer of sunburst.

Step 3

Repeat step 2 for medium and smallest layers, then glue all layers together, forming sunburst.

Step 4

Hot glue tails to back of bow.

Rural Ribbon

Supplies

- Three styles of ribbon
- Scissors

Step 1

First bow: Wrap small loop around thumb (this little loop will double as the bow's center knot). Then make four loops (two on each side).



Step 2

Second bow: Make two-loop bow, leaving tails long.

Step 3

Tie both bows together with third ribbon. Cut dovetail ends.



Two-Loop-Four-Tail Bow

Supplies

- Wired edge ribbon
- Scissors

Step 1

Create two-loop bow with long tails.



Step 2

Tie additional length of ribbon between loops, leaving ends long for extra tails.

Step 3

Trim tails as desired.
