SUPPLIES:

- Cotton Fabric
- Fusible Interfacing
- Clear Vinyl
- Double Fold Bias Tape
- Elastic Cord
- Chenille Stems
- Scissors
- Clips
- Sewing Pins
- Marking Pen
- Craft Thread
- · Measuring Mat



Cut two pieces of fabric, one piece of interfacing and one piece of vinyl according to templates. Iron interfacing onto one piece of fabric, then transfer template marks with marking pen.

Sew bias tape around curved side of vinyl.

Fold fabric pieces in half and sew over marks. Cut off excess fabric, leaving 1/4" seam allowance. Press open.

Clip fabric pieces, right sides together, with vinyl in between. Measure 3/8" from top and sew across. Repeat along bottom.

Turn mask right side out. Measure 1/8" from bottom and topstitch across. Measure 3/8" from top and topstitch length of vinyl. Insert 7 1/2" chenille stem through top hem.

Fold sides 1/4" and again 1/2", then hem.

Cut two 10" pieces of elastic. Insert elastic through hemmed sides and tie knot. Pull knot inside hem to hide.
















MASK & FACE SHIELD PATTERN (1 of 3)
