



- Place red Piece B and blue Piece B right sides together and sew down one short side.
 Press seam flat.
- 2. Fold lengthwise with right sides together and sew across long side. Turn.
- 3. Insert elastic and stitch at each end to hold.
- Fold red Piece A lengthwise with right sides together and sew across long side. Turn. Repeat with blue Piece A.
- 5. Wrap red Piece A around red end of Piece B and pin. Stitch and backstitch to secure. Pull backwards over seam. Repeat with blue pieces.
- 6. Fold band in half, offsetting edges so bottom edge of one end matches middle seam on other end. Wrap top portion around to bottom and vice versa. Pin to secure. Stitch through all layers in a curved line.
- 7. Pull fabric away from seam to create faux knot.
