SUPPLIES

Grosgrain ribbon, jewelry wire, alligator clip, scissors, wire cutters, hot glue gun/glue sticks.



STEP 1

Cut 36" length of ribbon, place it right side down, and wrap ends toward center, forming figure-8 shape.



STEP 2

Bring looped ends together.



STEP 3

Fold center accordion-style to form bow.



STEP 4

Wrap center of bow with jewelry wire.



STEP 5

Hot glue 6 x $\frac{3}{8}$ " strip of ribbon around bow's center to cover jewelry wire. Hot glue alligator clip to back of bow.

On the cover:

Follow the same steps—this time with velvet ribbon and dove-tailed ends—for a chic take on the classic boutique bow.



IT'S BOW TIME

Boutique bows rely on ribbon that's at least 2" wide for their iconic double-take-worthy size, and they'll hold their shape best with stiff ribbon types like grosgrain, canvas and anything with a wired edge.

BEST IN BOW

This velvet wired-edge ribbon checks all the boxes on a bow-maker's wish list: stylish (thanks to the lush texture), sturdy (thanks to the wire edging), and statement-making (thanks to the 2 1/2" width).



TAILED IT

The top two bows started out as traditional boutique bows, but a couple snips turned them into cheer bows. Just cut the bottom loops, then trim the tails into whatever style the occasion calls for.
