# CLOCK

## Supplies:

- Resin
- Silicone mat
- Wood round tray (comes in pack of 3)
- Alcohol ink
- Glitter
- Powdered pigment
- Heat gun
- Clock hands and sweep
- High torque motor
- Satin spray paint

## Steps:

1. After spray painting tray, mix resin according to manufacturer's instructions. Then add glitter. Pour resin into tray, filling halfway. Let cure according to manufacturer's instructions.
2. Mix additional resin according to manufacturer's instructions. Pour resin into tray until nearly filled. Do not wait for it to cure.
3. Mix additional resin according to manufacturer's instructions and divide into cups. Add glitter, powdered pigment and ink as desired. Drizzle over uncured clear resin.
4. Use heat gun to blend colors and patterns as desired. Let cure according to manufacturer's instructions.
5. Mix additional resin according to manufacturer's instructions. Pour thin layer of resin into tray until filled. Let cure according to manufacturer's instructions.
6. Drill hole in center and install clock motor and hands according to manufacturer's instructions.



For faster mixing and fewer bubbles, try using an epoxy mixer to stir the resin.





# SIGN

## Supplies:


- Resin
- Silicone mat
- "Home" resin mold
- Pencil cup resin mold
- Mixing cup
- Water-based color tint
- Potpourri
- LED lights
- Rectangle wood box
- E6000® bonding glue
- Hot glue gun/glue sticks
- Twine
- Tweezers



# SIGN

## Steps:

1. Mix resin according to manufacturer's instructions and pour thin layer into mold. Using tweezers, add potpourri flowers to resin.
2. Remove lid and hardware from wood box, then tint as desired and let dry. Drill hole into box where "H" of mold will be placed, then pull LED lights through bottom of box.
3. Feed LED lights from wood box into resin mold. End of light string should be at "E," and the lights should lay flat.
4. Pour additional resin into "Home" mold. Let cure according to manufacturer's instructions.
5. Remove from mold.
6. Pull excess lights hanging from "H" back through hole drilled in box. Hot glue battery pack to underside of box. Adhere "Home" sign on top of box.
7. Add twine and any other décor to box, as desired. **Note:** Use pencil cup mold to make vase for floral decorations.





# CLOUD

## Supplies:


- Resin
- Silicone mat
- Cloud resin mold
- Pendant resin mold
- Silicone measuring cups
- Alcohol ink
- Powdered pigment
- Cutting machine
- Self-adhesive vinyl
- Vinyl transfer paper
- Fine cable chain
- Medium curb chain
- Screw eyelets
- Findings value pack kit
- Pliers
- Rotary tool



# CLOUD

## Steps:

1. Mix resin according to manufacturer's instructions and add small amount of pigment powder. This will be for the cloud and stars. Split mixture between two cups, then stir in alcohol ink to color resin as desired. Pour into cloud mold and star mold. Let cure according to manufacturer's instructions. Remove from molds.
2. Cut cloud shapes and stars from vinyl. Remove excess vinyl around design and apply transfer paper. Peel backing off of vinyl shapes, then adhere them to cured resin and peel off transfer paper.
3. Mix additional resin according to manufacturer's instructions and pour a clear layer over vinyl to seal it. Let cure according to manufacturer's instructions.
4. Cut name from vinyl. Remove excess vinyl around name and apply transfer paper. Peel backing off vinyl letters, then adhere them to cured resin and peel off transfer paper.
5. Pour additional clear resin over vinyl to seal it. Let cure according to manufacturer's instructions.
6. Use rotary tool to drill holes into bottom of cloud and through top of stars. Then screw eyelets into holes and attach jump rings to stars. Connect lengths of fine cable chain between eyelets and jump rings. To hang, cut length of medium curb chain and loop each end through holes in top of cloud. Use links at ends to secure.



# COASTER

## Supplies:

- Resin
- Silicone mat
- Resin coaster molds
- Silicone measuring cups
- Squeeze bottles
- Alcohol ink
- Glitter
- Powdered pigment
- Opaque casting pigment
- Heat gun



## Steps:

1. Mix resin according to manufacturer's instructions and pour into mold.
2. Add glitter in center of mold.
3. Mix additional resin according to manufacturer's instructions and pour into two squeeze bottles. Mix two drops of white pigment into one bottle and one drop of powdered pigment into the other.
4. Using squeeze bottles, paint design onto resin.
5. Use heat gun to blend colors and patterns as desired.
6. Let cure according to manufacturer's instructions.



**Note:** Follow safety precautions (such as wearing gloves and working in a well-ventilated area) when working with resin.
