BOHEMIAN DREAM

The longer you leave sola flowers in dye, the more vibrant the color becomes. That's the secret to the deep hues on this boho wall hanging. To create the look: Cut the stems from sola flowers and dried florals. Then arrange them on a vine disc, securing them with hot glue. Finish with torn strips of hand-dyed fabric.



FLORAL REPORT

We dyed these sola stems with acrylic paint! Wreath: Cut a steel ring in half, and insert the ends into holes drilled into a wood board, securing them with hot glue. Then arrange the florals on a halved foam disc, and glue the disc to the wood.

BOUQUET AWAY

The foam-like petals of sola flowers absorb liquid well, so it's easy to tint them with fabric dye. You can dye them to the perfect hue for your special day or keep them *au naturel*—a soft eggshell white.



FABRIC DYE

STEP-BY-STEP

Fabric dye is a simple and effective way to customize sola wood flowers.

SUPPLIES

- Sola wood flowers
- Vegetable glycerin
- Dye
- Measuring cups
- Bowl
- Spoon
- Water

STEP 1

Fill bowl with 1:3 mixture of vegetable glycerin to hot water. Stir well.

STEP 2

Add dye to mixture according to manufacturer's instructions.

STEP 3

Dip flower into dye bath until desired color is achieved. Let excess dye drip off, then set flower aside to dry.

ACRYLIC PAINT STEP-BY-STEP

Here's an alternate method for coloring sola wood flowers: acrylic paint. It offers a more subtle hue than fabric dye, so you can easily create your own custom colors without worrying about oversaturating the petals.

SUPPLIES

- Sola wood flowers
- Vegetable glycerin
- Acrylic paint
- Measuring cups
- Bowl
- Spoon
- Water

STEP 1

Fill bowl with 1:3 mixture of vegetable glycerin to hot water. Stir well.

STEP 2

Add paint to mixture until desired color is achieved. Stir well.

STEP 3

Dip flower into dye bath until desired color is achieved. Let excess paint drip off, then set flower aside to dry.
