From cover to cover, this decked-out photo book is made of chipboard! Start by folding a chipboard sheet in half to create the covers—be sure to score it in the center for the spine. Then add binder rings, hand-cut chipboard pages and tons of paper pretties.

PAGE TURNER

How to bring a photo book to life? Pack the pages with scrapbooking essentials like paper flowers, themed stickers, stamped designs and more!











You can make hand-crafted cards like these with just a few basic papercrafting supplies! Grab a box of blank cards, a paper pack (or two!), scissors, a tape runner and all the stickers your heart desires (we have hundreds to choose from!).









On the Cover: This greenhouseinspired display features cardstock cacti (placed in DIY paper pots), vines (embellished with paper flowers) and leaves (reinforced with floral wire stems).



MEMORY LANE

Vacation photos get the royal treatment with glittered paper!
Use a cutting machine to create regional symbols and landmarks, and make pictures pop off the page by backing them with foam adhesive dots.

OUT OF THE BLUE

Turn cardstock into geometric art! **Top:** Glue strips of paper into a shadowbox, mounting some with foam adhesive dots for depth, and layer a paper pattern on top. **Bottom:** Cut and stack abstract shapes, gluing rolled-up paper between the pieces for height.
