Pincushions

These felt pincushions get all of their intricate details from hand-sewn embroidery floss embellishments. Sew 'em, stuff 'em, and voila—a feast for the eyes!

Felt Book Cover

Here's every trick in the book for this felt-embellished book cover: Cut and adhere a felt sheet to fit the front, back and spine of your book, then pretty it up with beads and garden-worthy felt adornments.



Farmers Market Stand

Little hands harvest big imagination with this DIY felt farmers market stand! Everything from the fruits and veggies to the awning and banner are made of soft, kid-friendly felt.





For small, detailed projects like these, a blanket stitch is great for reinforcing thick seams, while a gathering stitch is perfect for achieving realistic frosting designs on macarons, cupcakes and more.

The blanket stitch is also ideal for toys since it ensures seams don't break loose during play!



Felt Animal Heads

Hand-cut felt pieces (these feature confetti, glitter and patterned varieties) make up these felt friends, while beads for eyes, handmade felt party hats and faux fur dial up the charm. Just glue them to wood rounds and hang.

Felt Napkin Rings

Felt sheets and a cutting machine make quick work of creating themed accessories, like these sea creature napkin rings. Layer your designs, adhere them to a ring of woven felt, and add seed beads for sparkle.



For a look that lasts, back your felt rings with jute ribbon—this prevents tearing!



On the Cover: Dress up a round paper mache box with felt flowers and embellishments, fill it with goodies, then open it up for your big reveal!

Tip: Use a machine stitch to create wood grain lines, and add extra details with an acrylic brush marker.



Felt Dollhouse

Layers of scalloped shingles, hand-cut windows, a door, and a handle for on-the-go play give this felt dollhouse a unique touch. Thanks to its all-in-one design, you can open it for extra room to play or use it as storage for toys!



Pro Tip: Assemble the house out of foam board, then sew felt around the house as desired.
