Dazzling Ideas for Jewelry-Making





PLENTY OF SPACE

Want to make your own out-of-this-world jewelry set? For these earrings, add moon rhinestone and opal planet charms to pieces of chain, and attach a set of ball posts and clutch backs. Then use the remaining length of chain to create a matching necklace.

ROLL THE DICE

Adding charms to readymade jewelry can really up your style game! Case in point: Attach a resin dice charm (which comes in a pack with eight colors to choose from) to a pearl beaded bracelet to give it a groovy, eclectic vibe.

SEA STYLES

Necklace: Attach nautical charms (starfish, pearl drop, sand dollar, blue zircon and anchor) to varied lengths of chain, group them on a jump ring, and add it to a paperclip chain necklace. Earrings: Affix faux turguoise charms into hoop chandelier earrings.

HEARTS OF GOLD

Psst... This rhinestone heart charm is a tiny locket. Layer the look with a simple gold heart charm-fine necklace chains keep the look delicate. P.S. The LOVE letters are from a pack of alphabet charms.



UNIQUE-CORN

You can let your imagination run wild with the huge variety of charms in the Charm Me[®] collection-and this unicorn mermaid necklace is the proof! Just hang the charm on a multicolor beaded choker, and it's ready to wear in just one step.

EAR ABOUT IT

The hammered metal texture on these gold earrings is what gives the minimal look a striking sense of detail. To add the pink bead bundle charms, you'll need to punch an extra set of holes in the discs. And here's a hint: The star pieces are in our blue star charms set.





FACE FORWARD

Here's a reason (or five!) to smile-these smiley face charms come in a single multipack. Hook them onto a chunky curb chain necklace to dial up the bold factor.

Tip: Center your largest charm for a balanced look.

GIVE IT A PEARL!

This nature-inspired pearl necklace features a gold-and-silver medley of itty-bitty pendantsincluding a rhinestone moon, a round tree and a bird & bird cage charm set-all hung from tiny rhinestone ring charms.



EAR-WINGS

No jewelry tools? No problem! For this super simple DIY, slide glass pearl teardrop and wing charms onto sterling silver hoops, and your earrings are ready to take flight.





COFFEE BREAK

A coffee lover's guide to a custom charm bracelet: Attach a set of coffee charms (sold together in a themed multipack) to a chain. Then give it a little extra oomph by hanging accent beads with headpins and threading deerskin lace cord through the chain.

GUMMY WEARS

This multipack of gummy bear charms is so cute you'll want to eat them (but don't!). Hook them onto a piece of chain, and use crimp beads to attach a DIY'd string of neon glass beads at the clasp.



CHARMED BRACELET

Handmade jewelry doesn't need to be complicated for it to be amazing. Simply string an open cross charm onto stretch cord and surround it with an array of beads–like this mix of agate, jade, quartz, clay and geode beads.

IN THE MIX

This bracelet set incorporates a mix of gold charms: rhinestone letters and rings, a You Are My Sunshine charm, a love hand symbols set, a Love tag and a glass bead bundle.

Tip: Punch holes in the love hand charm and secure it to the elastic cord with crimp beads.

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
