◀ RING TRUE

This textured towel ring features three layered circles of beads, courtesy of a right angle weave stitch. And for a look that lasts, string your beads onto durable leather cord. Then tie a loop at the end for hanging.

▼ JUST IN VASE

These vessels are display-ready thanks to beaded sleeves. Just choose some wood beads and elastic cord (the stretchiness will help the sleeve hug the container), and you're ready to weave! Use a peyote stitch to create the flowers and a right angle weave stitch for the rest.



HANG IN THERE

Combine wood beads, jute and terra cotta saucers to make this tiered hanging planter. Attach strands of jute to a split ring and begin stringing on beads. Use oval beads to connect and crisscross strands, bringing the ends together in the center and at the bottom to support the saucers.





FLYING COLORS ▲

Some of these jewelry pieces (looking at you, chunky necklaces and bracelets!) use bare wood beads that have been dip-dyed in water-based tint, while others mix and match beads from vibrant multi-packs and multicolored strands.

WOOD YOU BELIEVE ►

The natural textures of wood and Indian agate beads come together to create this earthy jewelry set. For the bracelets, string beads and a charm onto elastic cord for one-size-fits-all stretch. And for the necklace, use monofilament cord (it's stronger).





HOME SWEET HOME

Welcome guests to your humble abode with a wood bead-trimmed sign. Glue together three wood circles to make the base, then create a design with a wood-burning tool and colored pencils. To finish, glue a wood cutout in the center and the beads around the edge.

On the Cover:

After using a loom to weave your yarn as desired, attach large wood beads to the center with additional yarn and tie bead strands along the bottom.



IMAGINE THAT!

The four main arches of this mobile are wood wreaths cut in half, and the central rainbow is painted wood beads along jewelry wire. Heads up: The mushroom wood beads come bare and ready to paint.
