On the Cover:

Apply metallic finish and coarse texture spray paint onto galvanized metal containers, then apply a wax finish for this antique look.

AIM TO FRAME

Picture-perfect wooden frames in three simple steps! **1.** Tape off desired patterns and apply foil metallic spray paint (for a super high-gloss finish). **2.** Embellish with foil washi tape.

3. Spray on a sealer. Voila!

HAVE A SEAT

Surfaces finished with satin or glossy spray paint are easier to clean than their matte counterparts, so they're your best bet for keeping often-used pieces scuff (and grease and stain) free. After spraying thin layers over a DIY vinyl stencil, seal with polyurethane spray.

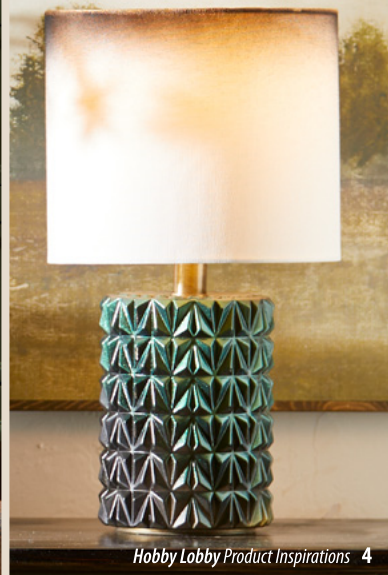


PAINT IT SWEET

When it comes to spray paint, temperature plays a factor. If it's too hot, the paint can run. But if it's too cold, the paint could dry unevenly. It's best to wait for warm weather, especially for projects that need to dry between coats (lamp: color morph finish, dresser: satin paint & primer).



Get this color-morph effect by applying the spray paint over a black basecoat.



Tip: Check the paint's label for recommended temperature guide.

SPRAY AWAY! ▶

If you want to accentuate the texture of a unique surface (cue these woven wall décor pieces), a satin finish is ideal because it lets the details shine through. But if you're trying to hide a rough surface's imperfections, go with a flat or matte finish.

SPRAY HELLO ▼

Some finishes go hand in hand with certain styles—like sea glass spray paint and a coastal aesthetic. The paint gives any glass surface, like these candle holders, a frosted, translucent look that dries in minutes.

Tip: Use multiple thin coats for a smoother finish.



FOR THE LOVE OF ART

Spray yes to a beginner-friendly project! Add layers and layers of vibrant glossy hues to a large blank canvas for this free-form mural-style wall art. **Tip:** To create graffiti-like drips, hold the can in one place instead of keeping it in motion.
