CACTUS SCRUBBY PATTERN

SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

The simple solution for making this kitchen scrubber look like a cactus: Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology 2.0 yarn! Each prickly polyester skein contains strands of tinsel throughout, giving the coarse texture a bit of eye-catching sparkle.

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg = beginning

bpdC = back post double crochet

ch(s) = chain(s)

dc = double crochet

ea = each

fpdc = front post double crochet

hk = hook

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

sc = single crochet

scblo = single crochet back loop only

sp = space

sl st = slipstitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

yo = yarn over

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Cactus: Approx. 4" tall x 3 ¾" wide

Planter Dish: 4" x 1 ¼"

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology 2.0, 3 oz (85 g) skeins of 174 yds (159 m):
 - Green (A) – 1 skein
- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Khaki (B) – 1 skein
 - Rosey (C) – 1 skein
- US size H (5 mm) crochet hook
- US size I (5.5 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle

SPECIAL STITCHES:

Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc): Yo and insert hk from front to back between posts of first and second dc of row below, and then from back to front again between posts of second and third sts. Yo and draw yarn around post of st (3 lps on hk). Yo and draw yarn through 2 lps on hk, twice.

Back Post Double Crochet (bpdC): Yo and insert hk from back to front between posts of first and second dc in row below, and then from front to back again between posts of second and third sts. Yo and draw yarn around post of st (3 lps on hk). Yo and draw yarn through 2 lps on hk, twice.

CACTUS INSTRUCTIONS (MAKE 2):

With 5 mm hk and A, ch 18.

Row 1: Dc in third ch from hk, dc in next 15 chs, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, fpdc in ea st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, bpdC in ea st across, turn.

Rows 4-23: Rep rows 2-3.

Row 24: Rep row 2, turn.

Fold in half, wrong sides together, and align edges.

Work 1 sc in ea st across. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Using yarn needle, weave yarn through open end and gather closed. Fasten off. Rep on opposite side. Flatten piece and stitch up center.

Place both pieces together, aligning stitched centers, and stitch again, going through both pieces. Fasten off.

FLOWER:

With 5.5 mm hk and C, make magic ring.

Rnd 1: 5 sc in magic ring. Sl st to join to beg st.

Rnd 2: (hdc, 3 dc, hdc) in ea st around. Fasten off, and tie onto cactus.

PLANTER DISH:

With 5.5 mm hk and B, make magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in ea st around.

Rnd 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (6 times).

Rnd 4: Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) (5 times).

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st (6 times).

Rnd 6: Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st (sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) (5 times), sc in next st.

Rnd 7: *Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st (6 times).

Rnd 8: Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st (sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st) (5 times), sc in next st.

Rnd 9: *Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st (6 times).

Rnd 10: Scblo in each st around.

Rnds 11-14: Sc in each st around. Fasten off and weave in ends.

IN BLOOM

The best part about these scrubby buddies is their sewn-on handles, making them easy to hold when you're dealing with tough messes. Plus, their thick, layered design is perfect for tackling daily dishes and even stubborn, baked-on stains.



FLOWER SCRUBBIES PATTERN

SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch(s) = chain(s)
dc = double crochet
ea = each
hdc = half double crochet
hk = hook
rnd(s) = round(s)
sc = single crochet
sl st = slipstitch
sm = stitch marker
sp = space
st(s) = stitch(es)
tc = triple crochet

MEASUREMENTS: 4"

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology Scrub It!,
3 oz (85 g) skeins of 79 yds (73 m):
 - Lemon (A) - 1 skein
 - Orange (B) - 1 skein
 - Bright Pink (C) - 1 skein
 - Aqua (D) - 1 skein
- US size J (6 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers

GAUGE:

6 scs and 6 rows = 2"

INSTRUCTIONS:

Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where ea new rnd begins.

FLOWER:

Rnd 1: With A, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1), (dc, ch1) (5 times in first ch), sl st to third ch. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Rnd 2: Join B in row 1 ch sp, ch2 (dc, tc, dc, hdc) in ch sp, ch1, [(hdc, dc, tc, dc, hdc) in ch sp, ch1] [5 times], sl st to second ch.

Rnd 3: Join C in row 2 ch sp, ch1, sc in ch sp, ch2, (sc in ch sp, ch2) (5 times), sl st to first sc.

Rnd 4: Ch1, [sc, wrapping row 3 sc and row 2 ch sp, ch1, (2 dc, tc, 2 dc) in ch sp, ch1] [6 times].

Rnd 5: Join D in row 4 sc, ch1, (sc in row 4 sc, ch4), (6 times), sl st to first sc.

Rnd 6: Ch1 (sc in row 5 sc, 5 sc in ch sp) (6 times), sl st to first sc (36 sts).

Fasten off.

BOTTOM:

Rnd 1: With D, ch2, 8 sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in ea st around (16 sc).

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 8 times (24 sc).

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) 8 times (32 sc).

Rnd 5: (sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st) 4 times (36 sc).

Fasten off and weave in ends.

BAND:

Rnd 1: With D, ch6, sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 4 chs, turn.

Rnds 2-13: Ch1, sc in next 5 sts, turn.

Fasten off.



FINISHING:

Align flower and bottom, wrong sides together. Place band in middle of bottom side. Sew around both edges, joining band at same time.

NOTE:

Colors B and C are switched for second flower.

LUCKY LADY

Here's the secret to making a handmade scourer uber-absorbent: Place a sponge, a foam pad or even polyester stuffing on the inside, and voila! Now your dish soap will soak right in, keeping your little ladybug extra sudsy.



LADYBUG SCRUBBY PATTERN

SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain
ea = each
hk = hook
sc = single crochet
scbl = single crochet back loop
scblo2tog = single crochet two together back loop only
sl st = slipstitch
st(s) = stitch(es)

MEASUREMENTS: 6" X 4 1/4" X 2"

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology Scrub It!, 3 oz (85 g) skeins of 79 yds (73 m):
 - Fire Red (A) – 1 skein
 - Black (B) – 1 skein
- US size J (6 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers

GAUGE:

6 sc and 6 rows = 2"

INSTRUCTIONS:

Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where ea new rnd begins.

BODY TOP:

Rnd 1: With A, ch2, 7 sc in second ch from hk.
Rnd 2: 2 scbl in ea st around (14 sts).
Rnd 3: (scbl in next st, 2 scbl in next st) 7 times (21 sts).
Rnd 4: (scbl in next 2 sts, 2 scbl in next st) 7 times (28 sts).
Rnd 5: (scbl in next 3 sts, 2 scbl in next st) 7 times (35 sts).
Rnd 6: (scbl in next 4 sts, 2 scbl in next st) 7 times (42 sts).
Rnd 7: (scbl in next 19 sts, scblo2tog) 2 times, sl st (40 sts).
Fasten off.

BODY TOP CENTER LINE:

Tie B to right side edge of body. Take yarn across to opposite side, insert it down and back to front and across to beginning point. Insert yarn wrong side to right side next to center line, cross perpendicularly, and insert right side to wrong side. Repeat perpendicular line on each body row. Fasten off.

DOTS (MAKE 4):

Rnd 1: With B, ch2, 8 sc in second ch from hk, sl st. Fasten off.

Sew dots on body right side 1/2" from center line and 1" apart from each other.

BODY BOTTOM:

Rnd 1: With A, ch2, 8 sc in second ch from hk.
Rnd 2: 2 sc in ea st around (16 sc).
Rnd 3: (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 8 times (24 sc).
Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) 8 times (32 sc).
Rnd 5: (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) 8 times (40 sc).
Rnd 6: Align top and bottom body pieces and then sc in ea st around, joining both pieces, sl st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

HEAD:

Rnd 1: With B, ch2, 8 sc in second ch from hk.
Rnd 2: (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) 2 times (10 sc).
Rnd 3: (sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) 2 times (12 sc).
Rnd 4: (sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st) 2 times, sl st (14 sc).
Fasten off.
Fold head flat and sew on edge of body perpendicular to body center line.



WATERMELON WASHCLOTH PATTERN

SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

Say goodbye to shabby kitchen sponges and hello to long-lasting dish cloths. These durable scrubbers are a great first-time crochet project. They're made mainly from the beginner-friendly half double crochet stitch, with bobble stitches for the watermelon seeds.

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain
ea = each
hdc = half double crochet
hk = hook
lp(s) = loop(s)
rep = repeat
sp = space
sl st = slipstitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
yo = yarn over

MEASUREMENTS: 8" X 8"

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology Scrub It!, 3 oz (85 g) skeins of 79 yds (73 m):
 - Bright Pink (A) – 1 skein
 - Black (B) – 1 skein
 - Green (C) – 1 skein
- US size J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook
- US size I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook

GAUGE: 12 sts and 10 rows of hdc = 4" square

SPECIAL STITCHES:

Bobble Stitch: yo, insert hk into st, yo, pull up a lp (3 times), yo, pull through all lps on hk. When changing colors, carry each yarn through end of row.

INSTRUCTIONS:

With A and size J hook, ch25.
Row 1: Hdc in third ch from hk and ea ch across, ch 2, turn.
Row 2: Hdc in ea st across, ch 2 turn.
Row 3: Hdc in next 3 sts, *with B, bobble in next st, with A, hdc in next 3 sts* (5 times), ch2, turn, fasten off B.
Rows 4-5: Hdc in each st across, ch2, turn.
Row 6: Hdc in next 5 sts, with B, bobble in next st, *with A, hdc in next 3 sts, with B, bobble in next st* (3 times), with A, hdc in next 5 sts, ch 2, turn, fasten off B.
Rows 7-8: Rep rows 4-5.
Row 9: Rep row 3.
Rows 10-11: Rep rows 4-5.
Row 12: Rep row 6.
Rows 13-14: Rep rows 4-5.
Row 15: Rep row 3.
Rows 16-17: Rep rows 4-5. Do not ch at end of last row. Fasten off.
With size I hk, join C in corner, 2 hdc in ea st around entire piece. Fasten off.





SPLASH ZONE

This crocheted soap pouch has just the right amount of scrubbing power while still being super soft on skin. And it's all thanks to the strong design yet gentle texture of Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology Cotton yarn. Look for it in a variety of multicolored skeins!

LOVELY LAMB

If you can do a single crochet stitch, you can make this baa-th time sheep! The loofah features Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology Scrub It! yarn, which is made of specially designed textured nylon. That means it will always be at-the-ready for a scrub-a-dub-dub.



SPLASH ZONE: SOAP POUCH PATTERN

SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS:

b_{pd}c = back post double crochet
ch(s) = chain(s)
dc = double crochet
ea = each
f_{ptr}cl = front post cluster
f_{pd}c = front post double crochet
h_{dc} = half double crochet
hk = hook
lp(s) = loop(s)
rep = repeat
sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slipstitch
sp = space
st(s) = stitch(es)
yo = yarn over

MEASUREMENTS: 4" X 7"

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology Cotton, 3 oz (85 g) skeins of 125 yds (115 m):
 - See You At Sunset (A) – 1 skein
- US size J (6 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle

GAUGE:

7 sc and 7 rows = 2"

SPECIAL STITCHES:

Front Post Cluster (f_{ptr}cl): *yo twice, insert hk behind st, yo, pull a lp, yo, pull through 2 lps, yo, pull through 2 lps, rep from * 5 times in same st, yo pull through all lps.

Front Post Double Crochet (f_{pd}c): Yo and insert hk from front to back between posts of first and second dc of row below, and then from back to front again between posts of second and third sts. Yo and draw yarn around post of st (3 lps on hk). Yo and draw yarn through 2 lps on hk, twice.

Back Post Double Crochet (b_{pd}c): Yo and insert hk from back to front between posts of first and second dc in row below, and then from front to back again

between posts of second and third sts. Yo and draw yarn around post of st (3 lps on hk). Yo and draw yarn through 2 lps on hk, twice.

Ch 1 counts as first st.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Row 1: With A, ch21, dc in third ch from hk, dc in next 18 chs, turn.

Row 2: Ch1, b_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 3: Ch1, f_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 4: Ch1, b_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 5: Ch1, f_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 6: Ch1, b_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 7: Ch1, f_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 8: Ch1, b_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 9: Ch1, f_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 10: Ch1, b_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 11: Ch1, f_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 12: Ch1, b_{pd}c in next 4 sts, (f_{pl}, b_{pd}c) (6 times), b_{pd}c in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 13: Ch1, f_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 14: Ch1, b_{pd}c in next 5 sts, (f_{pl}, b_{pd}c) (5 times), b_{pd}c in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 15: Ch1, f_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 16: Ch1, b_{pd}c in next 4 sts, (f_{pl}, b_{pd}c) (6 times), b_{pd}c in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 17: Ch1, f_{pd}c in next 19 sts, turn.

Row 18: Fold piece wrong sides together, aligning row 17 with row 1, and work 1 sc in all 20 sts, joining both ends. Fasten off and weave in ends.

FINISHING:

Close one of open edges.

Row 1: Join A in opposite edge and distribute 24 sc around it.

Row 2: Ch2, sk 1, (h_{dc} in next st, ch1, sk 1 st) (11 times), sl st to first ch.

Row 3: Ch2, dc in same st (2 dc in ch sp, 2 dc in next st) (11 times), 2 dc in ch sp, sl st to second ch. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make a twisted cord and insert it through row 2 of finishing instructions. Pull string and make a bow.

LOVELY LAMB: SHEEP SHOWER POUF PATTERN

SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain
ea = each
hk = hook
lp(s) = loop(s)
rep = repeat
sc = single crochet
sl st = slipstitch
sm = stitch marker
st(s) = stitch(es)

MEASUREMENTS: 4 1/2" around

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Scrub-ology Scrub It!,
3 oz (85 g) skeins of 79 yds (73 m):
 - White (A) – 1 skein
 - Black (B) – 1 skein
- US size J (6 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers

GAUGE:

6 sc and 6 rows = 2"

INSTRUCTIONS:

Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where ea new rnd begins.

BODY STEP 1 (MAKE 2):

Close one of open edges.

Rnd 1: With A, ch2, 6 sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in ea st around (12 sc).

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 6 times (18 sc).

Fasten off.

BODY STEP 2:

Rnd 1: Join A by inserting hk under post of first sc st in rnd 1 *(ch6, sc in second ch from hk and ea ch across) 2 times, sl st to next st post in rnd 1, rep from *5 times (ch6, 1 sc in second ch from hk and ea ch across) 2 times, sl st to next st in rnd 2.

Rnd 2: *(ch6, sc in second ch from hk and ea st across) 2 times, sl st to next st post in rnd 2, rep from *12 times (ch6, sc in second ch from hk and ea ch across) 2 times, sl st to next st post in rnd 3.

Rnd 3: *(ch6, sc in second ch from hk and ea st across) 2 times, sl st to next st post in rnd 3, rep from *18 times. Fasten off.

HEAD:

Rnd 1: With B, ch2, 8 sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) 2 times (10 sc).

Rnd 3: (sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) 2 times (12 sc).

Rnd 4: (sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, ch 5) 2 times, sl st (14 sc).

Fasten off.

FINISHING:

Join both body pieces together by sewing rnd 3 of each piece together. Join A in center and ch 35, join in center to make a lp. Fold head flat and sew to body. Stitch eyes to head.
