This tray started out as bare galvanized metal, but a couple coats of paint (matte chalk paint on the inside, glossy acrylic paint on the outside) and a handmade stencil turned it into a one-of-a-kind catchall. **Tip:** Seal the tray with decoupage medium to protect the paint job.

∨ MAKE IT POP

The 3D effect on these metal canisters comes from fast-drying plaster. Place a stencil on a primed canister, layering it a few times for a thick, raised design. Remove the stencil right away, let the piece dry, and seal it with decoupage medium.

Easy housewarming gift in three steps: 1. Paint the bottom half of a round metal sign with chalk paint. 2. Embellish with elements that speak to the giftee's style (ours features dried florals and fuzzy leopard paper). 3. Finish with a painted metal "Welcome" accent.

POCKET PLANTS

We used texture combs (found in Paper Crafts) to create the basket-like look of these metal wall pockets. Prime the pockets with spray paint, then apply a mixture of texture paste and acrylic paint. And before the mixture sets up, run the comb through it to create designs.
