HOBBY LOBBY®

PURSE PERFECT

Take your style on the go with this chic belt bag (thanks, wispy rose and mum fabric)! The strap (cotton webbing trim, swivel snaphooks, D-rings and a slide adjuster) is adjustable, so you can wear it crossbody or around your waist.

REST EASY

Traveling gets a little more relaxing (and a lot more stylish) with a matching sleep mask and travel pillow set. Try patterned cotton on the outside for style and white faux fur on the underside for comfort.





HANG IN THERE

Handmade fabric baskets make kitchen storage a breeze! And with dozens of fabric designs to choose from, the hardest part is picking your favorite ones. Handy hint: Add suede straps (found in the Crafts Dept.) so you can easily slide the baskets on and off DIY dowel hangers.



SLUMBER PARTY

Coordinating accent pillows instantly kick the cozy factor up a notch. To copy these dreamy vibes, opt for white and pink faux fur along with moody black cotton florals.

Tip: Brush the fur aside so you have a tangle-free line to sew along.

BEAR-Y CUTE

Four warm and fuzzy fabrics—faux furs, crystal fleece and anti-pill fleece—come together to add adorable creature comfort to a nursery or playroom.

Tip: Faux fur tends to be slippery, so if you're using the rug on a hard floor, place a non-slip mat underneath.





STEP UP

Give your décor a leg up with this two-tone ottoman! Staple brown and white long pile fur to foam-topped wood planks, and then screw on black hairpin legs (Home Décor Dept.). The fur gives the piece a rustic cabin aesthetic, and the sleek metal legs keep it modern.

On the Cover: To recreate this snuggly blanket, cut and sew together four long pile fabric rectangles. Then sew flannel on the other side to keep you nice and toasty.



MAKE ROOM

Floral prints, gingham accents, and a groovy color palette bring woodland vibes to these lightweight embellishments. The cap and stem of each mushroom are made of two layers, with fiberfill in between and decorative stitching for added detail.

IN THE BAG

Here's a stylish way to store dry goods! The outside and lining of these bags are machine-washable cotton fabric (great for kitchen projects!). They feature hook-and-loop strips that allow you to roll the bags closed. And the see-through window? White mesh sewn into the lining.
