



Hanging Around

Go boho-beautiful by pairing olive leaf garlands with readymade wood bead garlands. Connect them with floral wire and just let them drape for a natural airiness.

Orange You Glad

Multiple asparagus and leafy fern garlands make up this gorgeously green arrangement. Add a little zest by wiring in dehydrated orange slices—and this fresh-and-fruity look will be all yours!

On the Cover: Step up your garlands with these tips!

1) Add big blooms like roses and dahlias first, then work in filler florals. 2) Create a cohesive color story with similar shades throughout.

3) Spread out stems to keep things airy.







Light the Way

Here's a bright idea! This hanging light fixture features asparagus and wildflower garlands attached to water hyacinth basket wall hangings (secured together with jute).

To the Table

Attach mimosa sprays, berries and greenery to a eucalyptus garland to create this flowy centerpiece. Display the custom garland with taper candles in gold holders to up the elegance of the entire tablescape.



Hang of It

Garlands are beyond versatile—you can shape, bunch or cut them in so many ways! For this wall hanging, tie fern and baby's breath pieces to a birch stick, glue on cosmos for color, and hang it with jute.

Well Rounded

Talk about an all-around beauty—this vibrant wreath combines a grapevine wreath form, a mixed wildflower garland and ribbon. Just wrap and wire everything together and voila!
