# ON THE COVER: CROCHETED VELVET SCARF

Our velvet scarf with fur pompoms features a half double crochet stitch—it's a tighter stitch than a double crochet, which means this scarf keeps you extra cozy in cold weather.

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

## Abbreviations:

**beg** = beginning

**ch** = chain

**ea** = each

**hdc** = half double crochet

**hdc3loop** = half double crochet in the third loop

**hk** = hook

**rep** = repeat

**rnd(s)** = round(s)

**sc** = single crochet

**sc2tog** = single crochet 2 together

**sl st** = slip stitch

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**Measurements:** Approx. 6 ½" x 50"  
(without pompoms)

## Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 80 yds (73 m):  
Blush (A) – 3 skeins
- Yarn Bee® Fur the Moment, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 62 yds (57 m):  
Frosted Mauve (B) – 1 skein
- US size K/10 ½ (6.50 mm) crochet hook
- US size L/11 (8.00mm) crochet hook

**Gauge:** With A, 12 sts and 10 rows = 4" square of hdc

## Instructions:

With A and size K/10 ½ hk, ch 152.

**Row 1:** Hdc in ea ch across, ch 2, turn.

**Rows 2–13:** Hdc3loop in ea st across, ch 2, turn.

**Row 14:** Hdc3loop in ea st across. Turn to work down short edge, 2 hdc in corner, hdc in ea st across. Continue to hdc around entire scarf, placing 2 hdc in ea corner. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## Pompom (Make 4):

With B and size L/11 hk, ch 4, sl st to join to make a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Sc in ea ch around, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

**Rnd 2:** 2 Sc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

**Rnd 3:** \*Sc in next st, 2 sc in next, rep from \* around, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

**Rnds 4–5:** Sc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

**Rnds 6–7:** Sc2tog, sl st to join to beg. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## Finishing:

Insert piece of yarn through top of pompom, and then tie pompom to corner of scarf. Rep for all pompoms.



# FUR REAL

The fuzzy texture of this bucket hat comes from Yarn Bee® Fur the Moment—a specialty yarn that looks like fur and is equally chic. For this ultra-soft (but ultra-simple) hat, single crochet in the round all the way through, increasing at the brim.



**Skill Level:** Intermediate

## Abbreviations:

**beg** = beginning  
**ch** = chain  
**ea** = each  
**rep** = repeat  
**rnd(s)** = round(s)  
**sc** = single crochet  
**sl st** = slip stitch  
**sm** = stitch marker  
**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**Measurements:** Approx. 10 ½" x 12"

## Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Fur the Moment, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 62 yds (56.7 m):  
Mink – 2 skeins
- US size M/13 (9.00 mm) crochet hook
- Stitch markers

**Gauge:** 6 sts and 8 rows = 3"

## Instructions:

Place sm in first st of ea rnd.

Ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

**Rnd 1:** 6 Sc into ring.

**Rnd 2:** 2 Sc in ea st around. (12 sts)

**Rnd 3:** \*Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (18 sts)

**Rnd 4:** \*Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (24 sts)

**Rnd 5:** \*Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (30 sts)

**Rnd 6:** \*Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (36 sts)

**Rnd 7:** \*Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (42 sts)

**Rnd 8:** \*Sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (46 sts)

**Rnd 9:** \*Sc in next 11 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (50 sts)

**Rnds 10-23:** Sc in ea st around.

**Rnd 24:** \*Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (60 sts)

**Rnd 25:** \*Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (70 sts)

**Rnd 26:** \*Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (80 sts)

**Rnds 27-29:** Sc in ea st around. Sl st to join to beg.

Cut yarn and weave in ends.





## COZY CLUTCH

The texture on this clutch is all thanks to the puff stitch, which is ideal for creating a trendy, chunky look. And while you're stocking up on velvet yarn, don't forget to grab the hardware too: a metal chain, swivel hinge clasps and a latch lock buckle.

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

### Abbreviations:

<b>ch</b> = chain	<b>dc</b> = double crochet
<b>ea</b> = each	<b>hk</b> = hook
<b>lp(s)</b> = loop(s)	<b>rep</b> = repeat
<b>sc</b> = single crochet	<b>sk</b> = skip
<b>sm</b> = stitch marker	<b>sp</b> = space
<b>sl st</b> = slip stitch	<b>st(s)</b> = stitch(es)
<b>YO</b> = yarn over	

**Measurements:** Approx. 11" x 8"

### Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 80 yds (73 m):  
Olive – 6 skeins
- US size L/11 (8.00 mm) crochet hook
- Stitch markers
- Metal chain strap
- Latch lock buckle
- Swivel hinge clasps

**Gauge:** 10 sts and 10 rows = 4" square of sc (double-stranded)

### Special Stitch:

Puff stitch - \*YO, insert hk into st, YO and pull up a lp, rep from \* 3 times in same st, YO and pull through all lps on hk.

### Instructions:

**Note:** Entire pattern is worked with 2 strands of yarn.

**Main Piece:** Ch 24.

**Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hook and ea ch across, ch 1, turn.

**Rows 2-36:** Sc in ea st across, ch 1, turn.

**Row 37:** Sc in first 2 sts, ch 1, sk st, \*sc in next 2 sts, ch 1, sk st, rep from \* across, sc in last 2 sts, ch 1, turn.

**Row 38:** Sc in first 2 sts, puff st in ch sp, \*sc in next 2 sts, puff st in ch sp, rep from \* across, sc in last 2 sts, ch 1, turn.

**Rows 39-44:** Rep rows 37-38.

**Rows 45-47:** Sc in ea st across, ch 1, turn.

**Row 48:** Sc in first 10 sts, ch 3, sk 3 sts, sc in last 10 sts, ch 1, turn.

**Row 49:** Sc in first 10 sts, sc 3 into ch sp, sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in last st. Turn to work down side, sc in ea st across, 2 sc in corner, turn to work across bottom, sc in ea st across, 2 sc in corner, turn to work up side, sc in ea st across, 2 sc in corner, join.

**Side (Make 2):** Ch 7.

**Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hk and ea ch across, ch 1, turn.

**Rows 2-13:** Sc in ea st across, ch 1, turn.

**Row 14:** Sc in ea st across. Cut yarn, leaving tail long enough to sl st all sides to main piece.

### Finishing:

On one long side of main piece, count 34 sts up from bottom and place sm. Take one side piece and match corner with long tail to marked st. Sl st to join main piece and side piece together, going through both pieces. Work down side, across bottom, then up other side. Rep for second side piece.

### Attaching hardware:

Place buckle 7 rows down from top edge of inside front. Place buckle with hole where you sk 3 sts on bottom edge of flap. Clip swivel clasps to top of side pieces and attach chain strap.



## SCRUNCHIE SEASON

Scrunchies are a quick and easy beginner's project, but eye-catching velvet and fur yarn can make them look impressively boutique. Crochet around an elastic hair band, and be sure to adjust the hook size appropriately for each kind of yarn to keep the tension nice and snug.

### FUR SCRUNCHIE

**Skill Level:** Easy

**Abbreviations:**

- beg** = beginning
- sc** = single crochet
- sl st** = slip stitch

**Measurements:** Approx. 4"-5" circumference

**Materials:**

- Yarn Bee® Fur the Moment, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 62 yds (57 m):  
Wolf – 1 skein
- US size L/11 (8.00 mm) crochet hook
- Elastic hair band

**Instructions:**

**Rnd 1:** 30 Sc into elastic hair band. Sl st to join to beg st.

**Rnd 2:** Sc in ea st around. Sl st to join to beg.

Fasten off and cut ends.

### VELVET SCRUNCHIE

**Skill Level:** Easy

**Abbreviations:**

- beg** = beginning
- dc** = double crochet
- sl st** = slip stitch

**Measurements:** Approx. 4"-5" circumference

**Materials:**

- Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 80 yds (73 m):  
Olive – 1 skein  
Ivory – 1 skein  
Mustard – 1 skein
- US size K/10 ½ (6.50 mm) crochet hook
- Elastic hair bands

**Instructions:**

**Rnd 1:** With yarn color of choice, 50 dc into elastic hair band. Sl st to join to beg st.

Fasten off and cut ends.



## SWEATER WEATHER

Knit this trendy color-blocked sweater with Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth skeins—their soft texture glides effortlessly over circular knitting needles. By the way: The front, back, shoulders and sleeves are each separate pieces that we sewed together.



# VELVETY COLOR-BLOCKED SWEATER

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

**Abbreviations:**

**BO** = bind off

**CO** = cast on

**dec** = decrease

**inc** = increase

**k** = knit

**p** = purl

**rep** = repeat

**rnd(s)** = round(s)

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**Measurements:** Approx. 20" long x 18" wide with 19" sleeves

**Materials:**

- Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 80 yds (74 m):
  - Olive (A) – 3 skeins
  - Silver (B) – 2 skeins
  - Blush (C) – 2 skeins
  - Ivory (D) – 2 skeins
- US size 10 ½ (6.50 mm) circular knitting needles
- Yarn needle
- Knit counter
- Stitch holder

**Gauge:** 10 sts and 15 rows = 4"

**Instructions:**

Join and end colors, tying a knot on current yarn and leaving tail on the back.

Change colors in vertical and angled lines, crossing the colors on the purled side and grabbing next yarn over previous yarn.

**Front:**

**Note:** Turn at the end of each row.

With A, CO 46 sts.

**Rows 1-11:** P1, k1 across row.

**Row 12:** K17, join D, k29.

**Row 13:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 9 times, k1, p1.

With A, p1, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 5 times, k1.

**Row 14:** K17. With D, k29.

**Rows 15-58:** Rep rows 13-14.

**Row 59:** Rep row 13.

**Row 60:** Join B, k46.

**Row 61:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 15 times, k1.

**Row 62:** K46.

**Rows 63-66:** Rep rows 61-62.

**Row 67:** Rep row 61.

**Row 68:** K19, slide 8 sts in stitch holder, k19.

Continue working each shoulder separately.

**Left Shoulder:**

**Row 69:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 6 times, k1.

**Row 70:** Dec 2 sts, k16.

**Row 71:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 5 times, k1, p1.

**Row 72:** Dec 1 st, k15.

**Row 73:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 5 times, k1.

**Row 74:** Dec 1 st, k14.

**Row 75:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 5 times.

**Row 76:** Dec 1 st, k13.

**Row 77:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 4 times, k1, p1.

**Row 78:** K14.

BO.

**Right Shoulder:**

**Row 69:** Join B, dec 2 sts, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 5 times, k1.

**Row 70:** K17.

**Row 71:** Dec 1 st, p2, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 4 times, k1.

**Row 72:** K16.

**Row 73:** Dec 1 st, p1, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 4 times, k1.

**Row 74:** K15.

**Row 75:** Dec 1 st, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 4 times, k1.

**Row 76:** K14.

**Row 77:** P1, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 4 times, k1.

**Row 78:** K14.

BO.

**Back:**

**Note:** Turn at the end of each row.

With A, CO 46 sts.

**Rows 1-11:** P1, k1 across the row.

**Row 12:** Join D, k29, join A, k17.

**Row 13:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 5 times, k1, p1.

With D, p1, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 9 times, k1.

**Row 14:** K29. With A, k17.

**Rows 15-58:** Rep rows 13-14.

**Row 59:** Rep row 13.

**Row 60:** Join B, k46.

**Row 61:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 15 times, k1.

**Row 62:** K46.

**Rows 63-72:** Rep rows 61-62.

**Row 73:** Rep row 61.

**Row 74:** K16, slide 14 sts in st holder, k16.

Continue working each shoulder separately.

**Left Shoulder:**

**Row 75:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 5 times, k1.

**Row 76:** Dec 2 sts, k13.

**Row 77:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 4 times, k1, p1.

**Row 78:** K14.

BO.

**Right Shoulder:**

**Row 75:** Join B, dec 2 sts, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 4 times, k1.

**Row 76:** K14.

**Row 77:** P1, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 4 times, k1.

**Row 78:** K14.

BO.

**Left Sleeve:**

**Note:** Turn at the end of each row.

With A, loosely CO 20 sts.

**Rows 1-11:** P1, k1 across the row.

**Row 12:** Join B, k3, inc 1 st,\*k2, inc 1 st, rep from \* 7 times, k3. (28 sts)

**Row 13:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 9 times, k1.

**Row 14:** K28.

**Row 15-16:** Rep rows 13-14.

**Row 17:** Rep row 13.

**Row 18:** K1, inc 1 st, k26, inc 1 st, k1. (30 sts)

**Row 19:** P1, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 9 times, k1, p1.

**Row 20:** K30.

**Row 21-22:** Rep rows 19-20.

**Row 23:** Rep row 19.

**Row 24:** K1, inc 1 st, k28, inc 1 st, k1. (32 sts)

**Row 25:** P2, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 10 times.

**Row 26:** K32.

**Row 27-28:** Rep rows 25-26.

**Row 29:** Rep row 25.

**Row 30:** K1, inc 1 st, k30, inc 1 st, k1. (34 sts)

**Row 31:** \*K1, p2, rep from \* 11 times, k1.

**Row 32:** K34.

**Row 33:** Rep row 31.

**Row 34:** Join C, k34.

**Row 35:** Rep row 31.

**Row 36:** K1, inc 1 st, k32, inc 1 st, k1. (36 sts)

**Row 37:** P1, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 11 times, k1, p1.

**Row 38:** K36.

**Rows 39-40:** Rep rows 37-38.

**Row 41:** Rep row 37.

**Row 42:** K1, inc 1 st, k34, inc 1 st, k1. (38 sts)

**Row 43:** P2, \*k1, p2, rep from \* 12 times.

**Row 44:** K38.

**Rows 45-70:** Rep rows 43-44.

**Right Sleeve:**

Rep left sleeve instructions. In row 12, join C and continue using it until the end of the sleeve.

**Neckline:**

Sew front and back to the shoulders. Join A on neckline of the right shoulder. CO 10 sts, k over the sts on the st holder, CO 10 sts to complete front side. Continue CO 4 sts, join 14 sts on the st holder and finish with 4 more sts. K1, p1 all around for 4 rnds and then BO.

**Finishing:**

Center wide edge of sleeves with shoulder seam and sew across. Fold in half (right sides together) and sew along bottom of sleeves and down sides.





## BLANKET STATEMENT

The softest blanket throw pattern ever? Yes, please! Here's our big tip: Instead of adding traditional cut pompoms at each end, try crocheting spheres and stuffing them—they'll last much longer.

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

### Abbreviations:

**ch** = chain  
**dc** = double crochet  
**ea** = each  
**hdc** = half double crochet  
**hk** = hook  
**lp(s)** = loop(s)  
**rep** = repeat  
**rnd(s)** = round(s)  
**sc** = single crochet  
**sc2tog** = single crochet 2 together

**sc3tog** = single crochet 3 together

**sl st** = slip stitch

**sm** = stitch marker

**sp** = space

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**YO** = yarn over

**Measurements:** Approx. 36" x 42"

### Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 80 yds (73 m):  
Teal Green (A) - 10 skeins
- Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth Aran, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 161 yds (147 m):  
Caramel (B) - 4 skeins
- US size K/10 ½ (6.50 mm) crochet hook
- US size J/10 (6.00 mm) crochet hook
- Stitch marker

**Gauge:** 10 sts and 10 rows = 4" square of hdc

**Special Stitch:**

Bobble stitch - \*YO, insert hk into st and pull up a lp. YO, pull through 2 lps, rep from \* until you have 6 lps on hk. YO and pull through all 6 lps.

**Instructions:**

With A and size K/10 ½ hk, ch 105.

**Row 1:** Hdc in third ch from hk and ea ch across, ch 1, turn. (103)

**Rows 2-7:** Hdc in ea st across, ch 1, turn.

**Row 8:** Join B, hdc in first 3 sts, bobble in next st, \*hdc in next 3 sts, bobble in next, rep from \* 24 times, hdc in last 3 sts, ch 1, turn.

**Row 9:** Hdc in first st, bobble in next st, \*hdc in next 3 sts, bobble in next, rep from \* 25 times, hdc in last st, ch 1, turn.

**Row 10:** Rep row 8.

**Rows 11-23:** Join A, hdc in ea st across, ch 1, turn.

**Rows 24-26:** Join B, rep rows 8-10.

**Rows 27-39:** Rep rows 11-23.

**Rows 40-42:** Rep rows 8-10.

**Rows 43-55:** Rep rows 11-23.

**Rows 56-58:** Rep rows 8-10.

**Rows 59-71:** Rep rows 11-23.

**Rows 72-74:** Rep rows 8-10.

**Rows 75-87:** Rep rows 11-23.

**Rows 88-90:** Rep rows 8-10.

**Rows 91-103:** Rep rows 11-23.

**Rows 104-106:** Rep rows 8-10.

**Rows 107-113:** Hdc in ea st across, ch 1, turn.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

**Pompoms (Make 12):**

**Note:** Place a sm in the first st of ea rnd.

With B and size J/10 crochet hook, ch 3, sl st to make a ring.

**Rnd 1:** 6 Sc into ring.

**Rnd 2:** 2 Sc in ea st around.

**Rnd 3:** \*Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, rep from \* around. (18 sts)

**Rnds 4-6:** Sc in ea st around.

**Rnd 7:** \*Sc in next st, sc2tog, rep from \* around.

**Rnd 8:** Sc2tog around.

**Rnd 9:** Sc3tog around.

Insert polyfill inside pompom before last rnd. Cut yarn. Tie onto sides of blanket.







## RUG READY

Knit a soft and fuzzy rug with Yarn Bee® Fur the Moment yarn! This one features a simple stockinette stitch throughout (just switch yarn colors to create the design). Back it with both fabric and fabric stabilizer to finish.

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

### Abbreviations:

**BO** = bind off

**k** = knit

**rep** = repeat

**CO** = cast on

**p** = purl

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**Measurements:** Approx. 30" square

### Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Fur the Moment, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 62 yds (56.7 m)
  - Husky (A) – 3 skeins
  - Frosted Mauve (B) – 2 skeins
  - Black (C) – 1 skein
- US size 13 (9.00 mm) knitting needles
- Yarn needle
- Fabric
- Fabric stabilizer

**Gauge:** 11 sts and 16 rows = 5"

### Instructions:

Join and end colors, tying a knot on current yarn and leaving tail on the back.

Change colors in vertical and angled lines, crossing the colors on the purled side and grabbing next yarn over previous yarn.

With B, CO 38 sts. With A, CO 30 sts. (68 sts)

**Row 1:** With A, p30. With B, p38.

**Row 2:** With B, k38. With A, k30.

**Rows 3-18:** Rep rows 1-2.

**Row 19:** With A, p30. With B, p7. With C, p13. With B, p18.

**Row 20:** With B, k18. With C, k13. With B, k6. With A, k31.

**Row 21:** With A, p31. With B, p6. With C, p13. With B, p18.

**Row 22:** With B, k37. With A, k31.

**Row 23:** With A, p31. With B, p37.

**Row 24:** Rep row 22.

**Row 25:** With A, p22. With C, p23. With B, p23.

**Row 26:** With B, k23. With C, k23. With A, k22.

**Row 27:** Rep row 25.

**Row 28:** With B, k36. With A, k32.

**Row 29:** With A, p32. With B, p36.

**Row 30:** With B, k35. With A, k33.

**Row 31:** With A, p28. With C, p16. With B, p24.

**Row 32:** With B, k24. With C, k16. With A, k28.

**Row 33:** Rep row 31.

**Row 34:** With B, k34. With A, k34.

**Row 35:** With A, p35. With B, p33.



**Row 36:** With B, k32. With A, k36.

**Row 37:** With A, p36. With B, p32.

**Row 38:** With B, k31. With A, k37.

**Row 39:** With A, p37. With B, p31.

**Row 40:** With B, k30. With A, k38.

**Row 41:** With A, p39. With B, p29.

**Row 42:** With B, k29. With A, k39.

**Row 43:** With A, p40. With B, p28.

**Row 44:** With B, k27. With A, k41.

**Row 45:** With A, p42. With B, p26.

**Row 46:** With B, k25. With A, k43.

**Row 47:** With A, p44. With B, p24.

**Row 48:** With B, k23. With A, k45.

**Row 49:** With A, p46. With B, p22.

With A, p33.

**Row 78:** With A, k33. With B, k25.  
With A, k10.

**Row 79:** With A, p4. With C, p15.  
With B, p15. With A, p34.

**Row 80:** With A, k34. With B, k15.  
With C, k15. With A, k4.

**Row 81:** With A, p4. With C, p15.  
With B, p14. With A, p35.

**Row 82:** With A, k36. With B, k19.  
With A, k13.

**Row 83:** With A, p14. With B, p17.  
With A, p37.

**Row 84:** With A, k38. With B, k15.  
With A, k15.

**Row 85:** With A, p16. With B, p13.  
With A, p39.

**Row 86:** With A, k41. With B, k9.  
With A, k18.

**Rows 87-94:** Rep rows 55-56.

BO.

### **Finishing:**

Cut two 31" square pieces of fabric. Cut two pieces of fabric stabilizer to 30" long. Stitch stabilizer pieces together to create a 30" square. Sew fabric pieces right sides together with  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance, leaving an opening. Turn. Insert the stabilizer. Sew opening closed. Topstitch around with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Hand sew fur rug to the fabric on all sides.



## BAND TOGETHER

Here's a quick-to-make crochet project that's perfect for practicing increasing and decreasing!

This velvety headband uses just chaining and single crochet stitches. After binding off, wrap the piece around a 1½" plastic headband and sew the sides together.

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

### Abbreviations:

- ch** = chain
- ea** = each
- sc** = single crochet
- hk** = hook
- sc2tog** = single crochet 2 together
- st(s)** = stitch(es)

### Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 80 yds (74 m)  
Olive – 1 skein
- US size J (6.00 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- 1½" Plastic headband

**Gauge:** 6 sts and 8 rows = 3"

### Instructions:

**Note:** Turn at the end of ea row.

Ch 2.

**Row 1:** 5 Sc in second ch from hk.

**Rows 2-3:** Sc in ea st across.

**Row 4:** Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts. (6 sts)

**Rows 5-6:** Sc in ea st across.

**Row 7:** Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts. (7 sts)

**Rows 8-9:** Sc in ea st across.

**Row 10:** Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts. (8 sts)

**Row 11:** Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts. (9 sts)

**Row 12:** Sc in ea st across.

**Row 13:** Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts. (10 sts)

**Rows 14-28:** Sc in ea st across.

**Row 29:** Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog in next st, sc in next 4 sts. (9 sts)

**Row 30:** Sc in ea st across.

**Row 31:** Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog in next st, sc in next 4 sts. (8 sts)

**Row 32:** Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog in next st, sc in next 3 sts. (7 sts)

**Rows 33-34:** Sc in ea st across.

**Row 35:** Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog in next st, sc in next 3 sts. (6 sts)

**Rows 36-37:** Sc in ea st across.

**Row 38:** Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog in next st, sc in next 2 sts. (5 sts)

**Rows 39-40:** Sc in ea st across.

Cut yarn and weave in.

Sew both sides of yarn piece together, wrapping it around the headband.

# I ♥ HEADBANDS

Wrap yarn around a 1" plastic headband to create a velvety base, and secure it with glue. Then single crochet a row of 70 stitches across the top of the headband. To add a ruffle, crochet the next row through the single crochet stitches.



**Skill Level:** Intermediate

## Abbreviations:

- ch** = chain
- dc** = double crochet
- hdc** = half double crochet
- sc** = single crochet
- st(s)** = stitch(es)
- tc** = treble crochet

## Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Velvety Smooth Aran, 3.5 oz (100g) skeins of 161 yds (147m): Caramel – 1 skein
- US size J (6.00 mm) crochet hook
- Headband (1" wide)
- Glue
- Pen

## Instructions:

Wrap headband in yarn and secure with glue. Mark 1" from each end of headband.

**Row 1:** 70 Sc around headband, wrapping from one mark to the other. Turn.

**Row 2:** 2 Sc in next 5 sts, 2 hdc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next 10 sts, 2 tc in next 30 sts, 2 dc in next 10 sts, 2 hdc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next 5 sts.

Cut yarn and weave in ends.
