LIT LAUNDRY

This mini monochrome space comes together with elements of three miniature sets: a laundry room set (cabinets, basket, ironing board), a washer and dryer combo, and a kitchen set (table and sink).

DIY'd: balsa wood shiplap, bottle labels, balsa-wood-and-jute baskets.





BITE-SIZED DINING

The secret recipe for this kitchen scene? Embellishing readymade minis! Try painting them (mixer and toaster) or adding a hand-crafted element (faux marble countertop sculpted from clay).

DIY'd: black paper range hood and balsa cutting boards and shelves.





LITTLE LIVING

A little reupholstery is all it takes to give floral living room furniture a chic farmhouse makeover. And extra details, like a mini blanket ladder and wreath, sprinkle realism throughout the space.

DIY'd: basswood strip beams, fireplace (balsa wood pieces adhered to a foam block).



ITTY-BITTY BATH

The little goodies in this luxurious bathroom check all our boxes for the perfect pamper sesh—from pink rose vanity accessories to a gold-fixture bathtub.

DIY'd: board & batten walls, shower (balsa wood fixtures and polystyrene door), ribbon-spool-and-fabric ottoman.







HOLLY JOLLY HOME

Miniature porch lights cast an amber glow on this wintry scene, where every tiny detail—from the faux snow and mini trees to the golden reindeer next to Santa's sled—welcomes home the holidays.

DIY'd: NOEL letters and garland, window curtains, pine accents.



POPPY & CO

SMALL BUSINESS

Pop into this pretty flower shop, and you'll find all the mini makings of a flourishing gift sitting on custom-built shelves. They're made from four tiny wood cupboards, cut apart and combined into two smaller shelving units. Link them with dowel rods (for ribbon and wrapping paper) and balsa strips (a work surface).

DIY'd: corrugated paper pots, balsa wood crates.

Tip: Swap the screens on a mini traditional door with colored cellophane to create faux stained glass.
