HOBBY LOBBY®

HERE'S YOUR SIGN

...to create your own trendy letter board! Glue square dowels and basswood strips at right angles to make shelves, stain them, and adhere them to wood wall décor (this one comes pre-stained). Then spray paint wood squares white, and add letters cut from self-adhesive vinyl.



TOP SHELF ▶

For this fab boho-inspired shelf, paint a wood circle and screw metal hooks along one side. Then use wood glue to adhere two natural weathered wood planks together, and cut and drill holes on one side of the planks for macrame candle holders.

HANDLE WITH CARE ▼

This earthy centerpiece starts with whitewash wood wall décor for the base. To create a bamboo-style handle, thread wood barrel spools over three basswood strips, securing each spool with glue and screwing them into the base.



INFORMATION STATION

Can't find the perfect organizer for your family?

DIY one! Paint the base (plank wood wall décor) and screw on a galvanized metal planter (painted with a patina effect). Then finish the look with metal hooks and a small chalkboard.



NUMBERS GAME ▶

To craft a house numbers sign like this one, paint a slatted wood rectangle (we did an ombre effect), adhere wooden numbers, and add a border with stained balsa wood sheets. And the flower box? Stain a rectangular wood box and secure it to the front of the sign.

GARDEN FRESH ▼

Backing: Paint a slatted fir wood panel. **Herb boxes:** Stain three compartment wood boxes and screw them onto the base. **Labels:** Cover Baltic birch wood strips with chalkboard paint, cut them, and then glue them to the boxes.





On the Cover:

Recreate this mountain landscape with wood wall décor, Baltic birch strips, black acrylic paint, wood stain and bottle lights.

OH, HELLO!

How to turn a bare wood plank into this vertical welcome sign: Use wood stain to create a border around the plank, and then brush chalk paint onto the center. Add letters cut from self-adhesive vinyl, and top off your new sign with a DIY wreath.
