## Mirror, Mirror...

Embellished with grapevine branches, an assortment of mushrooms and moss, this mirror (found in Home Décor) is the fairest of them all!

*Tip: Soak a grapevine wreath in water to soften it—then you can cut, mold and shape it however you like.*





## Just Hangin'

Reconstruct a topiary ball into an organic oasis for these gnomes and their flower truck (they come in a set!). Move the inner branches to the sides and secure them with wire to create an opening, then decorate the ball with tiny floral picks.

## Home Tweet Home

We gave a plain wood birdhouse (look for it in the Crafts Department) the fairy-treatment to create this tweet-worthy home! A readymade floral door, teeny critters and walls made of birch rounds set the scene, complete with succulent picks and a miniature ladder.



## Natural Light

Flip the switch on this charming creation to reveal a hidden element: asparagus garland leaves glued inside the shade to create a silhouette effect that makes this lamp (embellished with moss, flowers and birds) the ultimate end table mood booster.





**On the Cover:** Base: cut-in-half grapevine wreath glued to moss-covered wood round.  
Swing: jute strung through holes in piece of balsa wood.



## Walls of Whimsy

Curate an eclectic garden gallery with ornate frames (from the Home Décor Department) bursting with butterflies, ladybugs, mushrooms and dragonflies! All it takes to create your own fairy-filled works of art is to pick your favorite pieces and glue them in place.

## Between the Pages

Here's the perfect book-nook addition for the library fairy who gets lost in page-turners. Carve wood-grain texture into five pieces of foam board, paint them, and glue them together into an open box. Complete the woody aesthetic with branches, moss and bottle lights.

## A Squirrel's Staircase

Spiraling wood rounds and climbing greenery make this lantern a whimsical woodland wonder for all of our nature friends!

**Tip:** Mix a bit of blue alcohol ink with resin to create a water-like effect—look closely, and you'll see that we did this inside the lantern.

## Gnome Grown

Build this town from the ground up by adding a treehouse, mushroom-lined gravel pathway and miniatures galore atop a patina-finished bucket.

**Tip:** Fill the base of the bucket with foam, then place a piece of foam board on top for a sturdy, flat surface.
