## WELCOME A-BOARD

When it comes to trimmers, more is more. Here, four layers of scalloped trim frame retro wave paper, cartoon alphabet stickers and DIY flowers (black vinyl, white cardstock and neon dot cutouts).

## POWER UP

Put the power of positive thinking to the test with an affirmations board. To get this look, start with teal bling bulletin board paper, corrugated coral trim and checkered gold trim. Finish with readymade "I Am..." cutouts and gold glitter letters.



## IMAGINE THAT!

Create a whimsical reading retreat by rolling, folding and gluing together a life-size paper tree!

**Trunk and Branches:** Kraft paper. **Leaves:** Green tissue paper and cardstock.

**Tip:** Hang up forest gnome cutouts and daisy retro trimmers to complete this woodland look!



**On the Cover:** Line cubbies with black poster board and personalize them with alphabet stickers and readymade cutouts. Then let students get creative with white chalk markers!

## OVER THE RAINBOW

The sky's the limit with these boho rainbow cutouts! Keep track of birthdays on this display featuring hand-cut raindrops and banners, layered trimmers, and rustic wood bulletin board paper.



## IT'S A DATE

## FOUR THE BEST

Layered cardstock letters, scalloped trims and glitter bulletin board roll make this groovy display board-turned-boardgame a real winner.

## TOP DESK

If you give neutral color palettes an A+, stock up on burlap bulletin board paper, chalkboard ivy trim and white scalloped trim. Extra credit: Black and white cardstock for endless custom cutouts!
