## Lavish & Full

Blooms galore may steal the show, but some hidden heroes also deserve a round of applause: foam blocks secured along the arch hold the flowers in place, while floral wire joins in to offer extra support.

## Cascading

Bring your wedding style full circle with a blossoming round arch inspired by the big day's bouquet! Attach two ready-to-embellish foam garlands along the top, then add in your florals of choice.





## *Asymmetrical*

Gorgeous arrangements of dahlias, hydrangeas and roses perfectly complement this understated, wooden arch. Having an outdoor wedding? Use stakes to keep the arch steady on even the windiest of days.





## Supplies

- Assorted florals
- Square wood arch
- Floral foam cage
- Ribbon
- Wire cutter
- Scissors
- Zip ties
- Floral wire

**Step 1:** Secure floral foam cage to arch with zip ties.

**Step 2:** Insert eucalyptus sprays into foam and arrange.

**Step 3:** Insert large focal flowers into foam, leaving space between stems.

**Step 4:** Fill with smaller flowers.



## Fabric Draped

Simple metal wedding stands get the royal treatment with layers of cascading chiffon. Shorten one of the arches and place it in front of the other for an offset look with maximum impact.



**Pro tip:** For extra stability, feed steel rods or wooden dowels through the stand's metal tubes while assembling.



## *Painted*

Hand-painted warm hues accented with dried floral elements—like cattails, palm spears and plenty of pampas grass—give this pair of wood panel backdrops their stunning boho look.
