Going green? Forego disposable gift wrap in favor of arranging a gardening gift set (DIY plant labels made from air-dry clay, mini terra cotta pots & more) in a large glass canister—a big green thumbs-up.

On the Cover: Make homemade potpourri look as good as it smells by adding DIY vinyl labels and spray painting the lids.



Top Dog

Create a treat for pets and pet parents alike by personalizing a corked glass jar with adhesive vinyl lettering and etching cream. Then make a showstopper topper out of cardstock, fabric and ribbon.

Welcome Home

A curated kitchen set can help make a house feel like a home! Choose an assortment of treats in stylish, reusable glass containers (here, a measuring cup, ribbed jars, mason jars and a handled jar with a wooden spoon).





Perfect Match

Eliminate the annual rummage-through-drawers birthday candle search with an always-ready set of candles and matches. Just decorate cylinder glass jars and place them in a DIY holder made out of cardstock, fabric and ribbon.



Jam Packed

Assemble matching jam jars for a gift worth preserving! Their rustic look comes courtesy of stamped wood labels glued to fabric rounds. A wooden spoon, suede lace and DIY wood shelf completes the country-chic set.





Tea Time

Glass is a great option when you're gifting edible—or in this case. drinkable-goodies. For this tea set, the 2oz glass jars and the milk bottle keep items sealed and fresh and the trendy glass mug keeps them stylish.

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch chain

ea each

Approx. 10" x 3 1/2"

MATERIALS:

Yarn Bee® Sugarwheel Cotton Sparkle™, 4.5 Oz (128 G) Skeins Of 296 Yds (270

M): Pretties Please (A) - 1 skein

US size G-6 (4 mm) crochet hook

Yarn needle

Buttons

Label

GAUGE: 11 sts and 10 rows = 2"

INSTRUCTIONS: Separate colors and use them as follows when the color changes: Yellow, orange, blush, coral, pink, blue, green. With yellow, ch 48.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from

hk and ea ch across.

Row 2: Ch 1, (sc in next st, ch1, sk st) 23 times, sc in next st, turn.

Row 3: With orange, ch 1, sc in next st. (sc in next ch-sp, ch 1, sk st) 22 times, sc in next ch-sp, sc in next st, turn,

Row 4: Ch1, (sc in next st, ch 1, sk st) 23 times, sc in next st, turn,

Rows 5-6: With blush, rep rows 3-4, turn.

Rows 7-8: With coral, rep rows 3-4, turn.

Rows 9-10: With pink, rep rows 3-4, turn.

Rows 11-12: With blue, rep rows 3-4, turn.

Rows 13-14: With blush, rep rows 3-4, turn.

Rows 15-16: With yellow, rep rows 3-4, turn.

Rows 17-18: With orange, rep rows 3-4, turn.

FINISHING: Working around project, sc in ea sc until you reach last side. Ch 6, sc in next 8 sts (x2). Ch 6, sl st to last st.





Seal Team

Add an elegant touch to correspondence with a wax seal kit. Fill mini glass jars with wax beads and embellish them with ribbon and wax seals. Complete the gift with stamps and a warming spoon nestled into a stained decorative box (found on the unfinished wood craft aisle).
