



On the cover: For the marbled domino effect, fill a domino mold halfway with white resin, sprinkle in terrazzo chips. and cure. Repeat with dyed resin, then fill in the details with enamel paint, and voilà!

IN FULL BLOOM

Create a one-of-a-kind domino set by following these simple steps! SUPPLIES: Casting resin, Dominoes silicone mold, Mixing cup, Opaque casting pigment, Dried flowers, Tweezers, Enamel paint, Paintbrush & Stir sticks





Mix resin following manufacturer's instructions, then fill mold partway and let cure.



Add dried flowers, then top with another layer of resin and let cure.



Mix opaque pigment with resin, fill remainder of mold, and let cure. Remove dominoes from mold and paint details.

PERFECT PAIR

Bookmarks and keychains make a darling duo! Achieve the look with Rectangle & Groovy Alphabet mold sets, resin and addins—think mica powder. charms (from a creation kit) and patterned paper.

Don't forget! After curing, add holes for keychain hardware (Jewelry Department) and DIY tassels.

FLOWER POWER

This floral tray is serving up serious style! Simply pour resin into a mold, add inclusions at different layers, then finish it off with handles of your choice (hint: these ones are drawer pulls from Home Décor).







PIGMENT POSSIBILITIES

1. Acrylic Paint: Creates an opaque color.

2. Liquid Dye: Leaves a translucent finish.

3. Mica Powder: Adds dimension and a shimmery effect.




WORK OF ART
