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# POT HOLDERS PATTERN

For these breakfast pot holders, a one-by-one approach is best. Make the toast, then crochet toppings separately and stitch them onto the toast.

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**MEASUREMENTS:** Approx. 6" x 6"

## MATERIALS:

- I Love This Cotton!® Yarn, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
  - Brown (A) - 1 skein
  - Taupe (B) - 1 skein
  - Ivory (C) - 1 skein
  - Antique Gold (D) - 1 skein
  - Curry (E) - 1 skein
  - Rosie (F) - 1 skein
  - Burnt Sienna (G) - 1 skein
  - Spunky (H) - 1 skein
  - Bruschetta (I) - 1 skein
  - Warm Blush (J) - 1 skein
  - Sage (K) - 1 skein
  - Bright Citrus (L) - 1 skein
  - Forest (M) - 1 skein
- US size H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook
- Fusible fleece batting
- Yarn needle

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Beg ch does not count as a st.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

**Toast: Make 2 with B and 2 with D.**

Ch 27.

**Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hk and ea ch across, turn.

**Rows 2-26:** Ch 1, sc in ea st across, turn.

**Row 27:** Ch 1, sc in first st, hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, tr in next st, 2tr in next st, 3tr in next st, 2tr in next st, 1tr in next st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, tr in next st, 2tr in next st, 3tr in next st, 2tr in next st, 1tr in next st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, sc in last st. Fasten off.

Place same color pieces wrong sides together. While working around, following pattern below, insert batting. Join D to both B pieces. Join A to both D pieces.

Ch 1, sc in next 16 sts, sk 2 sts, sc in next 15 sts, (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner st, turn to work down side, sc in end of row, (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner st, sc across, (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner st, sc in the end of ea row. Sl st to join to beg, ch 20, sl st and fasten off.



## Bacon & Egg Toast:

### Egg:

With E, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** 5Sc in ring, sl st to join.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2sc in ea st around, sl st to join.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, 1sc in first st, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next st, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, 1sc in first 2 sts, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join.

**Rnds 5-6:** Ch 1, sc in ea st around, sl st to join. Fasten off.

**Rnd 7:** Join C, ch 1, scflo in first st, 2scflo in next st, (scflo in next st, 2scflo in next st) around, sl st to join.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next st, (1hdc in next st, 2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st) 2 times, 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, 1tr in next 2 sts, 2tr in next st, 1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1hdc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1sc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next st, 1hdc in next st, 2hdc in next st, sl st to join.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 1, 1sc in first 3 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next st, (1hdc in next 2 sts, 2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st) 2 times, 1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1tr in next 3 sts, 2tr in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts, 2dc in next st, 1hdc in next 2 sts, 1sc in next st, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next 2 sts, 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next st, 1hdc in next 2 sts, 2hdc in next st. Sl st to join.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, 1sc in first 4 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next st, (1hdc in next 3 sts, 2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st) 2 times, 1dc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st, 1tr in next 4 sts, 2tr in next st, 1dc in next 4 sts, 2dc in next st, 1hdc in next 2 sts, 1sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next 2 sts, 1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 4 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next st, 1hdc in next 3 sts, 2hdc in next st, sl st to join.

**Rnd 11:** Ch 1, sc in ea st around. Sl st to join. Fasten off.

### Bacon:

When joining and switching between colors, the unused color is carried along the top of the previous row. The current row is worked over the unused yarn.

With G, ch 19.

**Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hk and ea ch across, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 2sc in ea st across, fasten off. Join I, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, (sc in first 5 sts, 1dc in next 4 sts, 1sc in next 5 sts, 1dc in next 4 sts) 2 times, turn.

**Row 4:** Join H, with I, 1sc in first 2 sts, with H, 1hdc in next st, 1dc in next 4 sts, with H, (sc2tog) 4 times, 1sc in next st, with I, 1hdc in next st, 1dc in next 4 sts, (sc2tog) 4 times, with H, 1hdc in next 7 sts, turn.

**Row 5:** With I, 1sc in first 2 sts, (hdc2tog) 2 times, 1sc in next 6 sts, (hdc2tog) 2 times, with H, 1sc in next 6 sts, (hdc2tog) 2 times, 1sc in next 2 sts, turn.

**Row 6:** With H, 1sc in first 2 sts, join G, 2dc in next 3 sts, with H, 1sc in next 3 sts, join F, (hdc2tog) 4 times, with I, 1sc in next 6 sts, turn.

**Row 7:** With F, (1sc in next st, sc2tog, 1dc in next st) 5 times, 1sc in next st. Fasten off all yarns.



### Tomato & Avocado Toast:

#### Tomato:

With J, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** 4Sc in ring, sl st to join.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2sc in ea st around, sl st to join.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, 2sc in ea st around, sl st to join, fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** Join G, ch 1, 1sc in first st, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next st, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join, fasten off.

**Rnd 5:** Join F, 1sc in first 2 sts, 2sc in next st (1sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join. Fasten off.

**Rnd 6:** Join G, 1sc in first 3 sts, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join. Fasten off. Hand stitch details with E, F and G.

#### Avocado:

With double strands of L, ch 14.

**Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hk, (sc in next ch, 2sc in next ch) 5 times, 1sc in next 2 chs, fasten off. Turn.

**Row 2:** Join double strands of K, ch 1, 1sc in first 2 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next 6 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next 5 sts, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next 2 sts, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, 1sc in first 2 sts, (2sc in next st, 1sc in next 3 sts) 4 times, 2sc in next st, 1sc in next 2 sts. Fasten off.

For onions, with K and M, ch 3 or 4.

Sew all pieces to toast.

#### Onions:

With K and M, ch 3 or 4. Leave tails long to sew. Sew all pieces to toast.



## BREAD WINNER

When crocheting a bread basket like this, combining yarn is what's on the menu! The basket is single crocheted with three strands of yarn to give it a stronger, tighter structure.

## HOME RUN

If you're making a project that needs extra weight and thickness, like this table runner, use the double-stranded yarn technique. This method can also be used as a stand-in for heavier yarns.



# BASKET PATTERN

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

## ABBREVIATIONS:

<b>ch(s)</b>	chain(s)
<b>ea</b>	each
<b>hk</b>	hook
<b>lp(s)</b>	loops
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>rsc</b>	reverse single crochet
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>scblo</b>	single crochet back loop only
<b>scflo</b>	single crochet front loop only
<b>sl st</b>	slip stitch
<b>sm</b>	stitch marker
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>YO</b>	yarn over

**MEASUREMENTS:** Approx. 4" x 7"

## MATERIALS:

- I Love This Cotton® Yarn, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
  - Dove (A) – 2 skeins
  - Rosemary Cottage (B) – 1 skein
- US size J (6.0 mm) crochet hook
- Stitch marker

**GAUGE:** 7 sc x 8 rows = 2"

## SPECIAL STITCHES:

**Reverse single crochet (rsc):** Insert hk front to back into previous st to the right, YO, pull up lp, YO, pull through 2 lps on hk.

**Single crochet back loop only (scblo):** Insert hk on back lp of next st, YO, pull through st, YO, pull through 2 lps.

**Single crochet front loop only (scflo):** Insert hk on front lp of next st, YO, pull through st, YO, pull through 2 lps.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Split yarn into 3 same-sized skeins. Use 3 strands together.

Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where new rnds begin.

**Rnd 1:** With A, ch 2, 8sc in second ch from hk.

**Rnd 2:** 2Sc in ea st around (16 sts).

**Rnd 3:** (Sc in next st, 2sc in next st) 8 times (24 sts).

**Rnd 4:** (Sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) 8 times (32 sts).

**Rnd 5:** (Sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st) 8 times (40 sts).

**Rnd 6:** (Sc in next 4 sts, 2sc in next st) 8 times (48 sts).

**Rnd 7:** (Sc in next 5 sts, 2sc in next st) 8 times (56 sts).

**Rnd 8:** (Sc in next 13 sts, 2sc in next st) 4 times (60 sts). Sl st.

**Rnd 9:** Combine 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B, ch 1, 1scblo in next 60 sts, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 10:** Combine 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B, ch 1, 1sc, (1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd, 1sc in next 3 sts) 14 times, 1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd, 1sc in next 2 sts, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 11:** Combine 3 strands of B, ch 1, (1sc in next 3 sts, 1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd) 15 times, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 12:** Combine 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B, ch 1, 1sc, (1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd, 1sc in next 3 sts) 14 times, 1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd, 1sc in next 2 sts, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 13:** Combine 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B, ch 1, (1sc in next 3 sts, 1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd) 15 times, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 14:** Combine 3 strands of A, ch 1, 1sc, (1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd, 1sc in next 3 sts) 14 times, 1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd, 1sc in next 2 sts, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 15:** Combine 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B, ch 1, (1sc in next 3 sts, 1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd) 15 times, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 16:** Combine 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B, ch 1, 1sc, (1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd, 1sc in next 3 sts) 14 times, 1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd, 1sc in next 2 sts, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 17:** Combine 3 strands of B, ch 1, (1sc in next 3 sts, 1sc in next st wrapping previous rnd) 15 times, sl st to first ch. Fasten off.

## Top Edge:

Use 2 strands of A.

**Rnd 1:** Join A on a ch, 1scblo in next 60 sts.

**Rnd 1a:** Continue in rnd 17, 1scflo in next 60 sts.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 1rsc in next 60 sts (wrap rnds 1 and 1a).

Fasten off and weave in ends.

# TABLE RUNNER PATTERN

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner

## ABBREVIATIONS:

## MEASUREMENTS:

Lg Circle = Approx. 12"

Med Circle = Approx. 10"

Scalloped Circle = Approx. 7"

Leaf = Approx. 4" x 3 1/2"

## MATERIALS:

- I Love This Cotton!® Yarn, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
  - Parchment (A) - 4 skeins
  - Serene Spa (B) - 8 skeins
- US size 1/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 12 sts and 6 rows = 4" square of dc

## SPECIAL STITCHES:

**dc2tog:** YO, insert hk in same st, draw up lp, YO, draw through 2 lps, YO, insert hk in next dc, draw up lp, YO, draw through 2 lps (3 lps left on hk), YO and draw through remaining 3 lps.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

**Note:** Each pattern uses double strands of yarn. Beg ch counts as st unless noted otherwise.

### Lg Circle (Make 2):

With A, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3, 11dc in ring, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, 1dc in same st, 2dc in ea st around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 3, 1dc in same st, 1dc in next st, (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 3, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next st, (1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 3, 1dc in same st, 1dc in next 3 sts, (2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts) around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 3, 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 2 sts, (1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 2 sts) around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 3, 1dc in same st, 1dc in next 5 sts (2dc in next st, 1dc in next 5 sts) around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 3, 1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts, (1dc in next 3 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts) around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 3, 1dc in same st, 1dc in next 7 sts, (2dc in next st, 1dc in next 7 sts) around. Sl st to join to beg. Fasten off.

### Med Circle (Make 2):

Follow Lg Circle pattern Rnds 1-7.

### Scalloped Circle (Make 3 with A and 3 with B):

Make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3, 19dc in ring, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2, 1hdc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 3, 1dc in same st, 2dc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 2, 1hdc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next st, ch 4, sk 2 sts, sc in next st, (ch 4, sk 2 sts, sc in next st) 11 times, ch 4, sk 2 sts, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 6:** (5dc in ch sp, sc in next sc) around. Sl st to join to beg. Fasten off.

### Leaf (Make 10):

With A, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3, 12 dc in ring, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, dc in next st, ch 1, (dc2tog in same and next st, ch 1) around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st to first ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3sc in same sp, 3sc in next ch-1 sp, (2sc, 1hdc) in next ch-1 sp, (2hdc, 1dc) in next ch-1 sp, 3dc in next ch-1 sp, (1dc, 2tr) in next ch-1 sp, ch 2, (2tr, 1dc) in next ch-1 sp, 3dc in next ch-1 sp, (1dc, 2hdc) in next ch-1 sp, (1hdc, 2sc) in next ch-1 sp, 3sc in next 2 ch-1 sps, sl st to join to beg. Fasten off. Using yarn needle, sew all pieces together as desired.



## TOTE-ALLY COOL

The perfectly neat edge around this market bag is all thanks to the foundation single crochet stitch. It also gives the edge of the bag more elasticity than a regular chain stitch would.

## RING BEARER

Keep your dinner parties nice and knit with DIY napkin rings. To get this look, you'll need to be familiar with cable stitches (both front and back) and the basic purl stitch.

## MATERIALS:

- I Love This Cotton® Yarn, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
  - Dove (A) - 2 skeins
  - Aspyn (B) - 1 skein
  - Deep Teal (C) - 1 skein
  - Bruschetta (D) - 1 skein
  - Gold (E) - 1 skein
  - Rosy (F) - 1 skein
  - Pewter (G) - 1 skein
  - Rosey II (H) - 1 skein
  - Sage (I) - 1 skein
  - Serene Spa (J) - 1 skein
- US size J (6 mm) crochet hook
- Stitch marker
- Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 7 sc sts and 7 rows = 2"

## SPECIAL STITCHES:

**Foundation single crochet (fsc):** Insert hk under 2 lps of ch of last st, YO, pull up a lp, (YO, pull through 1 lp). This is the ch. YO, pull through 2 lps.

**Foundation single crochet joining previous row (fscjoin):** Insert hk under 2 lps of ch of last st and also in next sc of previous row, YO, pull up a lp, (YO, pull through 1 lp). This is the ch. YO, pull through 2 lps.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Front and back of bag are foundation single crocheted.

Turn at end of ea row.

### Back:

**Row 1:** With A, ch 2, insert hk in second ch from hk, YO, pull up a lp, (YO, pull through 1 lp). This is the ch. YO, pull through 2 lps, 50fsc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 7 times, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, 2fsc, sk 2 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 7 times, 1fscjoin, 2fsc, sk 2 sts, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

**Rows 4-37:** Rep rows 2-3.

**Row 38:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 7 times, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

### Front:

Cut yarn and weave in every time color changes.

**Row 1:** With A, ch 2, insert hk in second ch from hk, YO, pull up a lp, (YO, pull through 1 lp). This is the ch. YO, pull through 2 lps, 50fsc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 4fsc. With H, 1fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 2fsc. With A, 3fsc, sk 5 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 4 times, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, 2fsc, sk 2 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 3 times, 1fscjoin, 4fsc. With H, 1fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin. With A, (5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin) 2 times, 2fsc, sk 2 sts, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, (5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin) 2 times, 2fsc. With H, 3fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 4fsc. With A, 1fsc, sk 5 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 4 times, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, 2fsc, sk 2 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 3 times, 1fscjoin, 3fsc. With H, 2fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 1fsc. With A, 4fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 2fsc, sk 2 sts, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, (5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin) 2 times, 1fsc. With H, 4fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 2fsc. With F, 3fsc, sk 5 sts. With B, 1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts. With A, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 3 times, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, 2fsc, sk 2 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 2 times, 1fscjoin. With B, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 3fsc. With F, 2fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 1fsc. With H, 4fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 1fsc. With A, 4fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, 1fscjoin, 2fsc, sk 2 sts, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

**Row 38:** With A, ch 1, 1sc in next 2 sts, 5fsc, sk 5 sts, (1fscjoin, 5fsc, sk 5 sts) 7 times, 1fscjoin, 1hdc.

### Gusset (Make 1):

Turn at end of ea row.

With A, ch 12.

**Row 1:** 1Sc in second ch from hk and ea st across (11 sts).

**Row 2:** Ch 1, (1sc in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st) 6 times, 1sc in last st.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, (1sc in next st, 1sc in next ch-sp) 6 times, 1sc in last st.

Rep rows 2-3 until gusset is long enough to wrap around left side, bottom and right side of bag. Join gusset between front and back pieces with sc sts.

### Top Edge:

**Rnd 1:** Join A where back and gusset are joined. Work an even number of sc sts around top of bag (working from back piece to first gusset to front piece to second gusset).

**Rnd 2:** Join C, ch 1, (1sc in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st) around, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 3:** With A, ch 1, (1sc in next st, 1sc in next ch-sp) around, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 4:** Join H, ch 1, (1sc in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st) around, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 5:** With A, ch 1, (1sc in next st, 1sc in next ch-sp) around, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 6:** Join I, ch 1, (1sc in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st) around, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 7:** With A, ch 1, (1sc in next st, 1sc in next ch-sp) around, sl st to first ch.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 1, 1sc in ea around, sl st to first ch.

### Strap (Make 1):

With A, ch 6.

**Row 1:** 1Sc in second ch from hk and ea st across (5 sts).

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 1sc in ea around, sl st to first ch.

Rep row 2 until strap is 42" long.

Sew strap to top edge of gusset.

Beat the heat with this color-blocked trivet. The secret to the trend-forward bubble design? Wood beads! Just crochet around each bead completely, sew them together, and voila!

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, 1sc in first st, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next st, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, 1sc in first 2 sts, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join to beg.

Place wood bead in circle and continue crocheting around it.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, 1sc in first 2 sts, sc2tog, (1sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog) around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, 1sc in first st, sc2tog (1sc in next st, sc2tog) around sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 1, sc2tog around. Sl st to join to beg. Fasten off.

Using yarn needle, sew beads together to make trivet.

**Row 7:** P3, 4scb. With A, p2, 4scb. With A, p1.

**Row 8:** K3. With B, p2. With A, k4. With B, p2. With A, k3.

**Row 9:** P1, 4scb. With A, p2, 4scb. With A, p3.

**Rows 10-33:** Rep rows 2-9.

#### Diamond:

**Row 1:** With A, CO 14 sts. Turn at end of ea row.

**Row 2:** P1. With B, p2. With A, k8. With B, p2. With A, p1.

**Row 3:** P1, 4scf. With A, p4, 4scb. With A, p1.

**Row 4:** K3. With B, p2. With A, k4. With B, p2. With A, k3.

**Row 5:** P3, 4scf, 4scb. With A, p3.

**Row 6:** K5. With B, p4. With A, k5.

**Row 7:** P3, 4scb, 4scf. With A, p3.

**Row 8:** K3. With B, p2. With A, k4. With B, p2. With A, k3.

**Row 9:** P1, 4scb. With A, p4, 4scf. With A, p1.

**Rows 10-33:** Rep rows 2-9.

#### FINISHING:

- Sew ends together.
- Add a row of sc sts on ea side.
- Fasten off and weave in ends.

Crochet a cup cozy to keep your coffee hot and your hands cool!

**Gold:** Made of puffy, eye-catching bobble stitches.

**Multicolor:** A combo of single crochet and half-double crochet stitches.

## MATERIALS:

- I Love This Cotton!® Yarn, 3 oz (85 g) skeins of 153 yds (140 m):
  - Sunlit Seafoam (A) - 1 skein
  - Gold (B) - 1 skein
- US size H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook
- Twill labels
- Yarn needle

## SPECIAL STITCHES:

**Bobble Stitch (bo):** (YO and insert hk into st. YO and pull up a lp, YO and pull through two lps) (5 times in same st) YO and pull through all lps on hk.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Beg ch does not count as a st.

To adjust size, increase or decrease beg ch by multiples of 2.



## Sunlit Seafoam Cozy:

With A, ch 34, join ends to make a circle.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in second ch from hk and ea ch around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2, hdc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnds 3-4:** Ch 2, hdc in third lp in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 2, hdc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnds 6-11:** Rep rnds 3-5 (2 times).

Fasten off. Weave in ends. Sew on label.



## Bobble Cozy:

With B, ch 34, join ends to make a circle.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in ea ch around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 2, bo in first st, ch 1, sk 1 st, (bo in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st) around. Sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 2, bo in first ch sp, ch 1, sk 1 st, (bo in next ch sp, ch 1, sk 1 st) around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnds 5-7:** Rep rnd 4.

**Rnds 8-10:** Rep rnd 2.

Fasten off.

- I Love This Cotton!® Yarn, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
  - Ivory (A) - 1 skein
  - Warm Blush (B) - 1 skein
  - Gold (C) - 1 skein
  - Brown (D) - 1 skein
  - Black (E) - 1 skein
  - Rosey (F) - 1 skein
- US size H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook
- Wood dowel cap (1 ¼")
- Yarn needle
- Wood dowel (½")
- Wood round (4")

## INSTRUCTIONS:

### Coaster (Make 4):

Beg ch does not count as st.

With double strands of C, ch 8, join ends to make a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 12sc in ring, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 1sc in first st, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next st, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join to beg. Fasten off.

**Rnd 3:** Join A, ch 1, 1sc in first 2 sts, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sk 1 st, 5dc in next st, sk 1 st, (sc in next st, sk 1 st, 5dc in next st, sk 1 st) around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, sc in first st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, 3tr in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, (sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, 3tr in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st) around, sl st to join to beg.

With B, embroider lines onto coaster as desired.

## Bee:

### Body:

With C, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 6sc in ring, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2sc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, 1sc in first st, 2sc in next st, (1sc in next st, 2sc in next st) around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, 1sc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

Place wood dowel cap inside circle and continue crocheting around it.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, 1sc in first st, sc2tog (1sc in next st, sc2tog) around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, sc in ea st around, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc2tog, (sc in next st, sc2tog) around, sl st to join to beg. Fasten off.

### Wing (Make 2):

With A, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 6sc in ring, sl st to join to beg.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2, 2hdc in first st, 2dc in next st, 2tr in next 3 sts, 2dc in next st, sl st to join to beg. Leave tail for sewing.

## FINISHING:

- Sew wings onto body.
- With D, E and F, embroider details onto bee.
- DIY base by cutting dowel to preferred size. Adhere to wood round. Insert wood dowel cap bee to top.



## PERFECT PLACE

Cotton yarn is a great choice for heavy-use items like these crocheted place mats. Why? It's absorbent (so spills are no match for it) and it's machine washable if spills do occur.

  - Parchment (A) - 2 skeins
  - Black (B) - 2 skeins
- US size I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook

**GAUGE:** 12 sts and 6 rows = 4" square of dc

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Pattern is worked with double strands throughout.

Pattern is worked with the right side facing and joining the end of each round. When switching between colors, the unused color is carried along the top of the previous round. The current round is worked over the unused yarn.

Beg ch 2 does not count as a st.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

With double strands of A, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2, 12dc in ring. Sl st to join to first st. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Join double strands of B, ch 2, 2dc in each st around. Sl st to join to first st.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 2, 2dc in first st, 1dc in next st, (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) around, sl st to join to first st.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 2, 1dc in first st, 2dc in next st,

1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, (with A, 1dc in next st, with B, 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st) 5 times, with A, 1dc in next st, making last YO with B, sl st to join to first st.

**Rnd 5:** With B, ch 2, 1dc in first st and next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts, (with A, 2dc in next st, with B, 1dc in next 3 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts) 5 times, with A, 2dc in next st, making last YO with B. Sl st to join to first st.

**Rnd 6:** With B, ch 2, 1dc in first st and next 3 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts, (with A, 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, with B, 1dc in next 4 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts) 5 times, with A, 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, making last YO with B, sl st to join to first st.

**Rnd 7:** With B, ch 2, 1dc in first st and next 4 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts, (with A, 1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, with B, 1dc in next 5 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts) 5 times, with A, 1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, making last YO with B, sl st to join to first st.

**Rnd 8:** With B, ch 2, 1dc in first st and next 5 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts, (with A, 1dc in next 3 sts, 2dc in next st, with B, 1dc in next 6 sts, 2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts) 5 times, with A, 1dc in next 3 sts, 2dc in next st, sl st to join to first st. Fasten off B.

**Rnd 9:** With A, ch 2, 1dc in first st and next 6 sts, 2dc in next st, (1dc in next 7 sts, 2dc in next st) around. Sl st to join to first st.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 2, 1dc in first st and next 7 sts, 2dc in next st, (1dc in next 8 sts, 2dc in next st) around. Sl st to join to first st. Fasten off.

**Rnd 11:** Join B, ch 1, sc in same st, sk 1 st, 5dc in next st, sk 1 st, (sc in next st, sk 1 st, 5dc in next st, sk 1 st) around. Sl st to join to first st. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
