



TULIPS

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg beginning ch(s) chain(s) double crochet dc

ea each

half double crochet hdc

hk hook

repeat rep rnd round

single crochet SC slip stitch sl st stitch(es) st(s)

three triple crochets together tc3tog

MEASUREMENTS:

Bulb is approx. 3" tall when complete

Leaves are approx. 4" tall

MATERIALS

Colors below are for the pink tulip pictured. Use different colors to achieve desired look.

- I Love This Cotton[™], 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Warm Blush (A) 1 skein
 - Ivory (B) 1 skein
 - Sage (C) 1 skein
 - Buttercup (D) 1 skein
- US size E-5 (3.5 mm) crochet hook
- 18-gauge floral wire
- · 22-gauge floral wire
- Hot glue gun / glue sticks

GAUGE: 10 sts and 6 rows = 2'' square of sc

INSTRUCTIONS:

Small Petal (Make 3)

With A, ch 11.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hk, hdc, 5 dc, hdc, sc, 3sc in next ch, sc in next ch on bottom side of row, hdc, 5 dc, hdc, sc. SI st to join to beg st, ch 1.

Rnd 2: (Crochet around 18-gauge floral wire) 10 sc, 3sc in next st, 9 sc, 2sc in last st. Sl st to join. Fasten off.

Large Petal (Make 3)

With A, ch 11.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hk, 8 sc, 3sc in next st, 8 sc, 2sc in last st, sl st to join, ch 1.

Rnd 2: 2Sc in first st, hdc, 6 dc, hdc, sc, 3sc in next st, sc, hdc, 6 dc, hdc, 2 sc, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

Rnd 3: (Crochet around 18-gauge floral wire) 12 sc, 3sc in next st, 11 sc, 2sc in last st. SI st to join. Fasten off.

Flower Center (Make 1)

With B, make magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 6, sc in second ch and next 4 chs, sl st into ring.

Rnds 2-3: Rep Rnd 1.

Fasten off. Pull to close ring.

Leaf (Make 2)

With C, ch 20.

Rnd 1: 2Sc in second ch from hk, 3 hdc, 9 dc, 3 hdc, 2 sc, 3sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 hdc, 8 dc, 3 hdc, 2 sc, sl st to join to beg, ch 1.

Rnd 2: Add 18-gauge wire, 20 sc, 3sc in next st, 18 sc, 2sc in last st. Sl st to join. Fasten off. Place two 18-gauge wires through center of center piece. Bend ends to secure. Begin wrapping green yarn around wires.

Place smaller petals, layered with larger petals. Secure with hot glue. Wrap green yarn down stem and hot glue to adhere end. Hot glue leaves to stem.

Bow (Make 1)

With D, ch 40, sl st to make magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, dc in next 14 chs, hdc in next ch, sc in next 4 chs, hdc in next ch, dc in next 14 chs, hdc in next ch, sc in next 2 chs, sl st.

Rnds 2-4: Ch 1, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 14 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 14 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, sl st.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, (align 22-gauge wire to previous rnd and crochet over in this rnd) sc in ea st around, sl st. Cut yarn and weave in.

Join D in Rnd 1 and rep Rnd 5.

Tail (Make 1)

With D, ch 87.

Row 1: Dc in third ch from hk, dc in next 40 chs, hdc in next ch, sc in next 3 ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 37 chs, tc3tog, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, dc in next 38 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 37 sts, tc3tog in last sts, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, dc in next 37 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 35 sts, tc3toq in last sts, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, dc in next 35 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 34 sts, tc3tog in last sts, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, (align 22-gauge wire to previous row and crochet over in this row) sc in next 75 sts, ch 1, continue around distributing 11 sc in short side, ch 1, sc in next 85 sts, continue around distributing 11 sc in short side, ch1, sl st.

Center Strap (Make 1)

With D, ch 13.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hk, and ea ch across, turn.

Rows 2-3: Ch 1, sc in next 12 sts.

Cut yarn.

Join bow and tail in smaller places and wrap around the center strap. Add chain to tie on back.



MARIGOLD

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg beginning
ch(s) chain(s)

dc double crochet

ea each

hdc half double crochet

hk hook

sc single crochet

rnd round
sl st slip stitch

sm stitch marker

st(s) stitch(es)

tr treble crochet

MEASUREMENTS: Flower is approx. 3" x 3"

MATERIALS

Colors below are for the yellow flower pictured. Use different colors to achieve desired look.

- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Curry (A) 1 skein
 - Forest (B) 1 skein
- US size E-5 (3.0 mm) crochet hook
- 18-gauge floral wire
- Hot glue gun / glue sticks

GAUGE: 10 sts and 6 rows = 2'' square of sc

INSTRUCTIONS:

Petals (Make 1)

Beg ch 2 counts as st.

With A, ch 57.

Row 1: Dc in third ch from hk, dc in ea st across, turn (55).

Row 2: (Ch 4, sc in second ch from hk, sc in next ch, sl st in next ch, sl st in Row 1 same st, sl st in next st) 15 times, (Ch 6, hdc in third ch from hk, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, sl st in next ch, sl st in Row 1 same st, sl st in next st) 15 times, (Ch 8, tr in fourth ch from hk, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, sl st in next ch. sl st in next ch. sl st in next ch. sl st in next st) 25 times.

Receptacle (Make 1)

Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where ea new rnd begins.

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 4Sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: (Sc in next st, 2sc in next st) 2 times.

Rnd 3: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) 2 times.

Rnd 4: (Sc in next st, 2sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 2 times.

Rnd 5: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next

st, sc in next 2 sts) 2 times.

Rnd 6: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) 4 times.

Pnd 7: (Sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st)

Rnd 7: (Sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st) 4 times, sl st to next st. Fasten off.

Leaf (Make 2)

Follow pattern for each leaf around stem.

With B, ch 16.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 14 chs, ch 1 continue around, sl st in next 6 sts.

Leaf 1: Ch 9, sl st in second ch from hk, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 3 chs, hdc in next ch, sl st in Row 1 next 3 sts.

Leaf 2: Ch 8, sl st in second ch from hk, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, sl st in Row 1 next 3 sts.

Leaves 3-6: Repeat Leaf 2.

Leaf 7: Repeat Leaf 1.

Beg with shortest end, roll tightly around two 18-gauge floral wires (opposite way leaves curl) and hot glue to secure as you go. Place wire through receptacle and secure on bottom of flower with hot glue.

Wrap yarn around wire, adding leaves as you go.



BASKET ARRANGEMENT

Crochet bouquets come together much like real arrangements-you'll want to use a mix of large standout blooms, smaller filler flowers, and greenery.

Tip: Add a crochet basket to complement the lush look!

BASKET PATTERN

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

ABBREVIATIONS:

bpdc back post double crochet bpsc back post single crochet

ch(s) chain(s) double crochet dc

dc2tog double crochet 2 together front post double crochet fpdc fpsc front post single crochet

hk hook

single crochet SC slip stitch s st space sp stitch(s) st(s)

repeat rep rnd round

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 17" around x 3.75"

MATERIALS

- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Brown (A) 1 skein
 - Antique Gold (B) 1 skein
- US Size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook
- Basket 5.44" x 5.44" D
- 20-gauge floral wire

GAUGE: 10 sts and 11 rows = 2'' square

When switching between colors, carry yarn behind color being used.

INSTRUCTIONS:

With A, ch 63, sl st to make ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in all sts around.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), 1 dc in next st, 2dc in next st, with B, 1 dc in next 4 sts, (with A, 1 dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st, with B, 1 dc in next 4 sts) 8 times, sl st to second ch.

Rnd 3: With A, fpsc, ch 2, 1 fpdc in next 3 sts, with B, 1 bpdc in next 4 sts, (with A, 1 fpdc in next 4 sts, with B, 1 bpdc in next 4 sts) 8 times, sl st to second ch.

Rnd 4: With B, bpsc, ch2, 1 bpdc in next 3 sts, with A, 1 fpdc in next 4 sts, (with B, 1 bpdc in next 4 sts, with A, 1 fpdc in next 4 sts) 8 times, sl st to second ch.

Rnds 5-6: Rep Rnd 4. **Rnds 7-9:** Rep Rnd 3.

Rnds 10-12: Rep Rnd 4.

Rnd 13: With A, ch1, sc in all sts around.

ASSEMBLY:

Place crochet wrap around basket.

Continue scrolling to see all the patterns for each of the flowers in the crochet basket.





OLIVE LEAVES

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg beginning ch(s) chain(s)

double crochet dc

dec decrease ea each

half double crochet hdc

hk hook increase inc

rnd round single crochet SC sl st slip stitch

stitch marker sm st(s) stitch(es)

tc3tog three triple crochets together MEASUREMENTS: Stem is 12"

MATERIALS

- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 a) skeins of 180 vds (165 m):
 - Olive (A) 1 skein
 - Forest (B) 1 skein
 - Sage (C) 1 skein
- US size C-2 (2.75 mm) crochet hook
- 20-gauge floral wire
- 24-gauge floral wire

GAUGE: 12 sts and 8 rows = 4'' square of dc

INSTRUCTIONS:

When adding wire around leaves, ensure you leave long tail for assembly.

Leaf (Make 7)

With desired color, ch 15.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hk. place sm, 1 sc, 2 hdc, 5 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc, 3sc in last st.

Continue on other side of chs, 2 sc, 2 hdc, 5 dc, 2 hdc, sc, sl st to beg.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, add 20-gauge wire, 14 sc, (sc, ch 2, sl st, sc) in next st, 14 sc, sl st to beg. Fasten off, leave long tail.

Olive (Make 3)

With desired color, make magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6Sc in ring, sl st to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2sc in ea st around.

Rnds 3-5: Ch 1, sc around, sl st to join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, (2sc, dec) x 3, sl st to join. **Rnd 7:** Ch 1, (sc, dec) x 3, sl st to join.

Leave long tail for wrapping around wire. Fasten off.

Insert 20-gauge wire into bottom of olive. Wrap yarn around wire.

ASSEMBLY:

Wrap yarn around wire ends of leaf. Using two 24-gauge wires, attach leaves and olives to wire and secure by wrapping yarn around ends.



Put the petal to the metal...literally! Floral stem wire is instrumental for crafting shapable crochet creations—just stitch around the wire as you go!

Tip: Need sturdier blooms? Bundle multiple wires together.





LILY

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch(s) chain(s)

dc double crochet

ea each

hdc half double crochet

sc single crochet

sc2tog 2 single crochets together scblo single crochet back loop only

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 5" x 3"



MATERIALS:

Colors below are for the dual-toned pink lily pictured. Use different colors to achieve desired look.

- I Love This Cotton[™], 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Rosey II (A) 1 skein
 - Warm Blush (B) 1 skein
 - Sage (C) 1 skein
 - Antique Gold (D) 1 skein
- US Size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook
- Hot glue gun / glue sticks
- 20-gauge floral wire
- 26-gauge floral wire
- Poly-fill
- Stitch marker

GAUGE: 10 sts and 11 rows = 2''

INSTRUCTIONS: Petals (Make 6)

With A, ch 12.

Do not cut yarn if creating a solid colored petal.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 10 chs, cut yarn and weave in, turn.

Rnd 2: Join B, ch 1, 2sc in first st, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next st, 2sc in last st, ch2, 2sc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, 1sc in next st, 2sc in last st, ch 1, sl st to first st.

Rnd 3: SI st back to ch-sp, (align 26-gauge wire to previous rnd and crochet over in this rnd), sc in ch-sp, sc in next 13 sts, (2sc, ch2, 2sc) in ch-sp, sc in next 13 sts, sc in next ch-sp, ch 1, sI st to first st.

Leaf (Make 2)

Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where ea new rnd begins.

With C, ch 16.

Rnd 1: SI st in second ch from hk, sI st in next ch, sc in next 2 chs, hdc in next 7 chs, sc in next 2 chs, sI st in last 2 chs, ch 2, continue around sI st in next 2 chs, sc in next 2 chs, hdc in next 7 chs, sc in next 2 chs, sI st in last 2 chs, ch 1.

Rnd 2: (Align 26-gauge wire to previous rnd and crochet over it), 1 scblo in next 15 sts, 2 scblo in next st, ch2, 2 scblo in next st, 1 scblo in next 15 sts, sl st to ch-sp.

Lily's Bud (Make 1)

Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where ea new rnd begins.

With C, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 4Sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: (2Sc in next st) 4 times.

Rnd 3: Sc in next 4sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts.

Rnd 4: Sc in next 9 sts.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 2sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts.

Rnd 6: 2Sc in next st, sc in next 9 sts.

Rnd 7: Sc in next 5 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts.

Rnd 8: Sc in next 12 sts.

Rnd 9: Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts.

Rnd 10: Sc2tog, sc in next 9 sts.

Add poly-fill and continue next rnd.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts.

Rnd 12: Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts.

Rnd 13: Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts.

Rnd 14: Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts.

Insert 20-gauge wire to end. Wrap around with same color to join both pieces.

Lily's Stamen (Make 5)

With D, ch 4, leaving small tails on ea side. Fold it in half. Wrap tails of chs to 3.5" 20-gauge wire with C.

ASSEMBLY

Wrap small section of stamens together with two long 20-gauge wires overlapping in opposite direction. Glue 3 petals around stamens. Glue second layer of petals overlapping first ones. Wrap petals with C to long wire adding flower bud and leaves going down. Secure end.



HYDRANGEA

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch(s) chain(s)

dc double crochet

each ea

front loop only flo

half double crochet hdc

hdcblo half double crochet back loop only

hk

single crochet back loop only scblo

stitch marker sm stitch(es) st(s) repeat rep single crochet SC slip stitch sl st

MEASUREMENTS: Stem is 12"



MATERIALS:

Colors below are for the pink hydrangeas pictured. Use different colors to achieve desired look.

- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Sage (A) 1 skein
 - Rosey II (B) 1 skein
 - Warm Blush (C) 1 skein - Sunlit Seafoam (D) - 1 skein
 - Stone Wash (E) 1 skein
- US size E-5 (3.0 mm) crochet hook
- 18-gauge floral wire
- Seed beads

GAUGE: 12 sts and 8 rows = 4'' square of dc

INSTRUCTIONS: Flowers (Make 40)

With desired color, make magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 4sc in ring, sl st to join to first st. Pull to close ring.

Rnd 2: (Ch 2, dc in same st, ch 2, sl st into second ch from hk, ch 2, sl st into same st, sl st into next st) 4 times. Leave long tail for wrapping around wire. Fasten off.

For each flower, cut 6" piece of wire, slide on bead and fold wire in half, insert wire in center of flower and wrap wire with yarn tail.

TIP: Using small paint brush, dab bleach in center of flower to create fading color effect.

Leaf (Make 2)

Cut 5" piece of wire.

With A, ch 21, sc in ea ch across aligning and wrapping wire, turn. Fold fourth inch of wire on end.

Row 1: Ch 1, scblo in first 3 sts, hdcblo in next 2 sts, scblo in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 2: Skip first st, sc in next 4 sts, sl st in next st, ch1, turn.

Row 3: Sc in first 2 sts, 2hdc in the next st, 2dc in next st, hdc in next st, hdc in last scblo of Row 1, scblo, hdcblo in next st, scblo in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 4: Skip first st, sc in next 8 sts, sl st in next st, ch1, turn.

Row 5: Sc in first 2 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 5 sts, hdc in next st, hdc in last scblo of Row 3, hdcblo in next st, scblo in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 6: Skip first st, sc in next 9 sts, sl st in next st, ch1, turn.

Row 7: Sc in first 2 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, (2dc in next st) x3, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, hdc in last scblo of Row 5, hdcblo in next st, scblo in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 8: Skip first st, sc in next 12 sts, sl st in next st, ch1, turn.

Row 9: Sc in first st, hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, sl st in next st, dc in next st, 2dc in next st, dc in next st, sl st in next st, dc in next st, 2dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sl st in last scblo of Row 7. Begin working on bottom side of first half.

Row 10: Sc in next 20 sts, sc in first sc of Row 1 on opposite side, ch 2, turn, sc in second ch from hk. Rep Rows 1-9, changing all blo for flo.

ASSEMBLY:

Group 4-6 flowers, wrap yarn around wire. Using four 18-gauge wires, attach groups of flowers, wrap yarn around, add leaves to wire and secure by wrapping yarn around ends.



ROSE

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch(s) chain(s)

dc double crochet

ea each

hdc half double crochet

hk hook

rnd round

sc single crochet sk skip

sl st slip stitch

sm stitch marker
sp space

st(s) stitch(s)

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 3" x 2"



MATERIALS:

Colors below are for the solid pink rose pictured. Use different colors to achieve desired look.

- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Pink (A) 1 skein
 - Forest Green (B) 1 skein
- US Size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook
- Hot glue gun / glue sticks
- 20-gauge floral wire
- 26-gauge floral wire
- Stitch marker

GAUGE: 10 sts and 11 rows = 2'' Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where ea new rnd begins.

INSTRUCTIONS: Large Petals (Make 4)

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 5Sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: (2Sc in next st) 5 times.

Rnd 3: (Sc in next st, 2sc in next st) 5 times.

Rnd 4: (Sc in next st, 2sc in next st, sc in next st) 5 times.

Rnd 5: (Sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next st) 5 times.

Rnd 6: Sc in next 8 sts, 3sc in next st, 3hdc in next st, 3dc in next 5 sts, 3hdc in next st, 3sc in next 8 sts.

Cut yarn and weave in.

Medium Petals (Make 3)

With A, use large petal instructions Rnds 1-4.

Rnd 5: Sc in next 7 sts, 3sc in next st, 3hdc in next 4 sts, 3sc in next 5, sc in next 7 sts.

Cut yarn and weave in.

Small Petals (Make 3)

With A, use large petal instructions Rnds 1-3.

Rnd 4: 1 Sc in next 5 sts, 3sc in next 5 sts, 1 sc in next 5 sts.

Cut yarn and weave in.

Rose Bud (Make 3)

With A, use small petal instructions.

Leaf (Make sets of 3)

With B, ch 8.

Rnd 1: Sc second ch from hk, hdc in next st, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st, 2sc in last st, ch 2, 2sc in next st around, hdc in next st, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next st, ch1.

Rnd 2: (Align 26-gauge wire to previous rnd and crochet over in this rnd), (sc in next 2 sts, ch 2, twist the ch around) 4 times, (sc, ch 2,sc) in ch-sp, (ch 2, sc in next 2 sts twist the ch around) 4 times, sl st to ch-sp.

Cut yarn and weave in.

Rose Receptacle and Sepal (Make 1)

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 5Sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: (2Sc in next st) 5 times, sl st to next st.

Rnd 3: (Ch 6, sl st to second ch from hk, sc in next 2 chs, hdc in next 2 chs, sk 1 st and sl st to next st of previous rnd) 5 times.

Cut varn and weave in.

Bud Receptacle and Sepal (Make 1)

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 5Sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: (Ch 4, sl st to second ch from hk, sc in next 2 chs, sl st to next st of previous rnd) 5 times.

Cut yarn and weave in.

ASSEMBLY

Attach one leaf to 6" 20-gauge wire, wrapping with B. Join two more leaves ½" down. Glue one small petal, wrapping around two long 20-gauge wires, wrap two more petals around first one. Glue medium and large petals, distributing them around the previous petals. Glue sepal. Wrap wire with B, adding leaves going down. Secure end.



LAVENDER

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch(s) chain(s)

dc double crochet

hdc half double crochet

hk hook

rep repeat

sc single crochet

sl st slip stitch

MEASUREMENTS: Stem is 12"

MATERIALS

- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - French Lilac (A) 1 skein
 - Warm Blush (B) 1 skein
 - Sage (C) 1 skein
- US size E-5 (3.5 mm) crochet hook

- 1/8" dowel
- Hot glue gun / glue sticks

GAUGE: 10 sts and 6 rows = 2'' square of sc

INSTRUCTIONS:

Lavender

With A or B, ch 64.

Row 1: 5Dc in 4 ch from hk, *sc in next ch, ch 6 sl st to base of sc* rep from * across. Fasten off.

Leaves

With C.

Row 1: *Ch 12, sc in second ch from hk, sc in next ch, 2 hdc, 3 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc* *7 times.

ASSEMBLY

Wrap dowel with C, using hot glue to adhere. Wrap lavender around dowel, starting at top. Adhere with hot glue. Wrap leaves around dowel. Adhere with hot glue.



PEONY

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch(s) chain(s)

dc double crochet

ea each

hdc half double crochet

hk hook

rnd round

sc single crochet

MATERIALS:

Colors below are for the pink peony pictured. Use different colors to achieve desired look.

- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Rosey II (A) 1 skein
 - Bright Green (B) 1 skein
 - Antique Gold (C) 1 skein
- US Size F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook
- Hot glue gun / glue sticks
- 20-gauge floral wire
- 20 gaage nera, me
- 26-gauge floral wire
- Poly-fill
- Stitch marker

GAUGE: 10 sts and 11 rows = 2''

INSTRUCTIONS:

Petals Layer 1 (Make 1)

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6Sc in second ch from hk, sl st to first st, ch1, join 26-gauge wire.

Row A: Sc in next st in Rnd 1, ch

7 weaving the wire in the chs.

Row B: Fold wire back and work over it sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 3 chs, turn.

Row C: Ch 1, sc in next 4 sts, ch 2, turn.

Row D: Sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 4 sts, sc in next ch on Row A (crochet over wire), turn.

Row E: Ch 1, bring back wire and work

over it, sc in next 5 sts, turn.

Row F: Ch 1, fold wire back and work over it, sc in next 5 sts, sc in next ch on Row A (crochet over wire).

Repeat Rows A-F 6 times, sl st to first st.

Petals Layer 2 (Make 1)

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6Sc in second ch from hk, sl st to first st, ch 1, join 26-gauge wire.

Row A: Sc in next st in Rnd 1, ch 7, weaving the wire in the chs.

Row B: Fold wire back and work over it sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 3 chs, turn.

Row C: Ch 1, sc in next 4 sts, ch2, turn.

Row D: Sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 4 sts, sc in next ch on Row A (crochet over wire), turn.

Row E: Ch 1, sc in next 6 sts, turn.

Row F: Ch 1, sc in next 6 sts, sc in next ch on Row A (crochet over wire), turn.

Row G: Ch 1, bring back wire and work over it, sc in next 6 sts, turn.

Row H: Ch 1, fold wire back and work over it, sc in next 6 sts.

Repeat Rows A-H 6 times, sl st to first st.

Petals Layer 3 (Make 1)

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6Sc in second ch from hk, sl st to first st, ch 1, join 26-gauge wire.

Row A: Sc in next st in Rnd 1, ch 8, weaving the wire in the chs.

Row B: Fold wire back and work over it, sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 3 chs, turn.

Row C: Ch 1, sc in next 4 sts, ch 2, turn.

Row D: Sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 4 sts, sc in next ch in Row A (crochet over wire), turn.

Row E: Ch 1, sc in next 6 sts, ch 2, turn.

Row F: Sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 6 sts, sc in next ch in Row A (crochet over wire), turn.

Row G: Ch 1, sc in next 7 sts, turn.

Row H: Ch 1, sc in next 7 sts, sc in next ch on Row A (crochet over wire), turn.

Row I: Ch 1, bring back wire and work over it, sc in next 7 sts, turn.

Row J: Ch 1, fold wire back and work over it, sc in next 7 sts, turn.

Repeat Rows A-J 6 times, sl st to first st.

Peony Center (Make 1)

With C, ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 5 chs, turn.

Row 2: (Ch 6, sl st in next st, ch 6, sl st in same st) 6 times.

Cut yarn.

Leaf (Make 2)

With B, ch 8, weaving 26-gauge wire in the chs.

Row 1: Fold back and work over the wire sc in second ch from hk, sc in next 5 chs, 2sc in last ch, ch 2, sk wire, 2sc in next ch around, sc in next 5 sts, ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Sk 1 st, sc in next 6 sts, (2sc, ch 2, 2sc) in ch-sp skipping wire, sc in next 6 sts, ch 1, turn.

Row 3: Sk 1 st, sc in next 7 sts, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-sp skipping wire, sc in next 7 sts, ch 1, turn.

Row 4: Sk 1 st, sc in next 7 sts, (sc, ch 1, sc) in ch-sp skipping wire, sc in next 7 sts, ch 1, turn.

Row 5: Sk 1 st, sc in next 7 sts, sl st to ch-sp.

Receptacle and Sepal (Make 1)

Place sm in first st of ea rnd to mark where ea new rnd begins.

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 4Sc in second ch from hk.

Rnd 2: (Sc in next st, 2sc in next st) 2 times.

Rnd 3: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) 2 times.

Rnd 4: (Sc in next st, 2sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 2 times.

Rnd 5: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 2 times.

Rnd 6: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) 4 times.

Rnd 7: (Sc in next 3 sts, 2sc in next

st) 4 times sl st to next st.

Rnd 8: (Ch 6, sl st in second ch from hk, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, tc in next st, sl st in next fourth st of previous rnd) 5 times.

ASSEMBLY:

Attach peony's center to two long 20-gauge wires. Insert wire through layers 1, 2, 3 and receptacle, adding glue between them. Wrap wire with C, adding leaves going down. Secure end.



POPPY

MATERIALS

Colors below are for the blue poppies pictured. Use different colors to achieve desired look.

- I Love This Cotton™, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 180 yds (165 m):
 - Aqua (A) 1 skein
 - Black (B) 1 skein
 - Ivory (C) 1 skein
 - Forest (D) 1 skein
- US size E-5 (3.5 mm) crochet hook
- 18-gauge floral wire
- 22-gauge floral wire
- Hot glue gun / glue sticks

GAUGE: 10 sts and 6 rows = 2'' square of sc

INSTRUCTIONS: Petals (Make 4)

With A, make magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 5 sc in ring, (do not join) (pull to tighten ring), ch 1, turn.

Rnd 2: 2Sc in ea st, ch 1, turn.

Rnd 3: Sc across, ch 1 turn.

Rnd 4: 4 Sc, 2sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc, ch 1 turn.

Rnd 5: 3 Sc, 2sc in next 6 sts, 4 sc, ch 2.

Rnd 6: Begin working down bottom side of petal, crochet around 22-gauge wire, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 2 sc, 3sc in next st. Wrap wire so ends meet in center bottom. Continue working around wire, 2 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, continue working around petal top, 4dc in next st, 2dc in next 17 sts, 4dc in last st. SI st to join. Fasten off.

Flower Center (Black) (Make 1)

With B, make magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 6sc in ring, sl st to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 8, sl st to join to next st, (6 times). Fasten off.

Flower Center (Cream) (Make 1)

With C, make magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 5sc in ring, sl st to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2sc in ea st around, sl st to join.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc2tog (5 times), sl st to join.

Rnd 4: *Ch 3, sl st to join to next st* (5 times). Fasten off.

Leaf (Make 2)

With D, ch 17.

Rnd 1: Add 22-gauge wire, sc in second ch from hk, sc in next ch, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc, 3sc in last st, (working under side of chs) 2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc, sl st to join to beg.

Rnd 2: *Ch 3, sl st to same st, sk 1 st, sl st to next st* rep around. SI st to join to beg. Fasten off. Place two 18-gauge wires through center of black center flower piece. Bend end of wire to secure. Place ivory flower center piece on top of bent wire and hot glue to attach. Place flower petals under center, overlapping them. Secure with wire ends and hot glue. Begin wrapping green yarn around wires,

add leaves as you go. Hot glue to secure ends.
