Texture Tool

When it comes to achieving striking visual impact, texture tools (sold 6 to a pack!) will help you incorporate designs with depth. It's a foolproof way to create patterns like lines, swirls, scallops, crosshatches and more!



Tintable Medium

For a 3D effect, brush textured tintable medium over your dried painted design, then comb through the medium in sections with a texture tool. The result: raised, dimensional lines with soft, velvety texture.



On the cover: Palette Knife

Palette knife painting allows you to build thick layers and create unique texture.

Tip: Try pressing the knife down and then gliding it across the canvas for smooth, sweeping strokes.



Piped & Brushed

These life-like florals owe their illusion of movement to this piped and brushed technique: First, pipe along the outer edge of the petal, then use a flat brush to guide the paint toward the center to enhance fluidity and bring life to your design.






Detailed Piping

Dial up the realism in leaf designs with intricately piped details and veining! Start by outlining your leaf, then pipe veins as desired. Using a paintbrush, delicately feather out your designs with subtle brush strokes.

Cake Piping Tips

Create swirls, loops, petals and more with cake piping tips! From left to right: #1M Open Star Decorating Tip, #2D Drop Flower Decorating Tip, #32 Open Star Decorating Tip, #102 Petal Decorating Tip, #18 Star Decorating Tip.



Decorating Tips

No baking skills necessary for these faux cakes! To make your own coquette creations out of paint, pipe away on a round paper mache box with a #17 star tip & a #67 leaf tip for smooth, airy designs.
