POP-UP CARD

Beginner: A birthday card so full of whimsy it could pop—literally! Get the perfect pop-up every time by separately making, arranging, and attaching accordion elements for varying 3D effects.

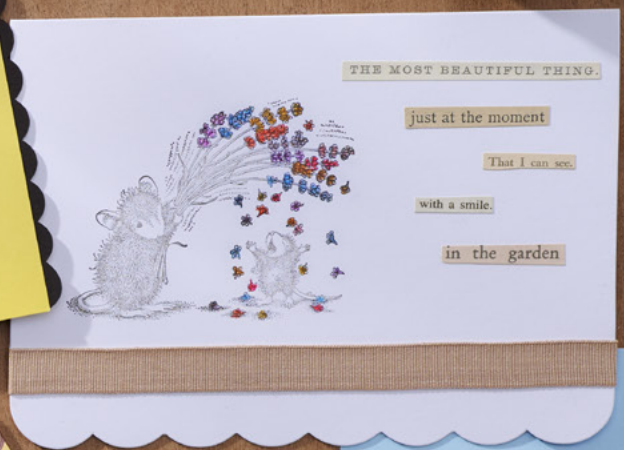
On the Cover: Punch Needle & Embroidered Cards

Advanced: Paper crafts + needle art = a must-try card making formula! You can either work directly on cardstock (embroidery) or craft the pieces separately and adhere them later (punch needle).



PATCHES & RHINESTONE STICKERS

Beginner: A hack for zhusing up blank cards? Go glam! Add stickers, sticker patches and rhinestones (or all three!) for an elevated look the lucky recipient is sure to take a shine to.



STAMPED CARDS

Beginner: With an endless selection of fun and trendy stamps (like cherries, butterflies & other cute critters, to name a few), you can create stylish cards for any occasion. Choose a theme, pick out embellishments... and stamp to it!





CARDSTOCK & CUTTING MACHINE

Intermediate: A cutting machine will be your best friend when you're working with layers of cardstock, foil paper or intricate paper details—like for shaker cards, accordion effects and raised 3D elements.

Back paper cutouts with foam adhesive squares to give them a boost, instantly creating designs with dimension!

HAND-PAINTED CARDS

Beginner: When you're trying your hand at hand-painted designs, opt for gouache paint.

It can be reactivated with water even after it's dry, making it easy to correct mistakes and rework areas if needed.





JUNK JOURNAL

Advanced: Take a page straight from junk journaling to create these vintage cards! Reach for ribbon, floral picks (found in Paper Crafts) and other ephemera—like fabric and chipboard—for the most maximalist-chic look.

WAX SEAL

Wax seals two ways!

Two-toned: Make a wax seal, cut out the stamped design (bow, heart & flower shown here), place the cutout back onto the stamp, then use the stamp again to make the finalized wax seal.

Photo: Make a wax seal, then glue a photo in the center.
