HOBBY LOBBY®

Tip: Use a low-temperature glue gun on floral foam pieces to prevent them from melting.



WONDERFUL WELCOME

Perfect a premade welcome sign for your perfect day! Try painting the back of this readymade clear sign to make the lettering pop. Then drill holes through the sign and a metal frame, and attach them with leather cording. Screw on wood planks for feet, and finish by adhering florals.

CENTER STAGED

Building centerpieces upward instead of out leaves more room around the table for guests. We flipped a metal frame centerpiece upside down and adhered a wood hexagon on top. Just hot glue foam blocks here and there to secure any floral sprays and picks.



AISLE AGLOW

Want to give your walk down the aisle a romantic glow? Place LED candles (no fire hazard here!) into wood basket lanterns. Then sit them atop an antique cake stand, and decorate the stand and aisle seats with matching floral picks and velvet trim.





PRESENT SENSE

Set up your gift station in a snap by letting readymade décor do the heavy lifting. The floral centerpieces, “Gifts” pennant wood décor and antique wedding card box all come ready to go! All we added: a DIY cardstock banner and extra florals, for *extra* flourish.

SITTING PRETTY

An ivory gauze table runner, pearl garland and florals (white peonies and ash leaf sprays) are all you need to give your seating some wedding flair. Simply drape your décor diagonally across the back of the chair, secure it all with floral wire, and you're done!

MARCH TO THE ARCH

No need to hire a construction team for the big day...this round wedding arch comes easy to assemble! Wrap floral foam garlands (secured with floral wire) around the arch to make a base for roses, baby's breath, pampas grass, hydrangeas, ferns and more.

On the Cover:

Make your place settings a feast for the eyes with readymade flowerpot card holders, stemmed glass candle holders, and floral picks like peonies, rabbit tails and eucalyptus.





The wooden "Mr. & Mrs." comes strung on jute cord. Our tip: Tie them onto gold metal hoops and embellish with florals for a little oomph.

THE HAPPY COUPLE

This is the time to put everything on the table...literally! Layers of ivory floral lace, satin and a gauze table runner create a base for elegant gold candlesticks and all the gorgeous florals (roses, hydrangeas, delphiniums and more).

GUESS WHO!

Here's a chic way to display your seating chart! Brush acrylic paint onto a wood arch panel, and secure cardstock onto the panel with gold wax and a heart seal. And the beautiful bouquet below? Pampas grass, palm spears, bamboo leaves and peonies.
