## **Belle of the Ball ◀**

How to transform a readymade mini bouquet into a hanging ball arrangement: Cut a hole through the center of a floral foam ball. Then thread ribbon through the hole, making a loop at the top and a tassel at the bottom. Finally, insert the flowers into the foam.

## **Light Show ▼**

Light your way down the aisle with customized wooden lanterns! Just cluster flowers at one corner of a wood frame centerpiece and insert an LED candle.

*Tip: For some extra drama, arrange a mini bouquet on a basswood round and place it beside the lantern.*





## Say Aisle Do ▲

These macrame baskets are perfect for a boho-inspired wedding. Fill them with floral foam and tuck in some pretty faux blooms.

**Tip:** To give the center of the arrangement extra height, wrap wire around the bottom of the floral stems before inserting them into the foam.

## Please Be Seated ▶

You can recreate this ethereal look with a pair of artfully draped gauze table runners. Gather the top runner to one side, add a trailing bouquet, and secure them with floral wire.

**On the Cover:** New to faux florals? Start with a readymade bouquet! These ranunculus blooms, rose picks and eucalyptus leaves come gathered together—just add some extra greenery and ribbon.



## Sign Up

Give your wedding guests a warm hello with a custom welcome sign. To create this look, back a readymade wall hanging with a painted wood circle, glue on pampas grass, and display the piece on an easel (find this one in the Wedding Department).





## Chair Flair ▲

These vases come wrapped in burlap ribbon, but you can up the wow-factor by adding woodburned hearts. For a look like ours, fill the vases with ranunculus picks, and hang them with twine (grouping them in threes). Then top it all off with an oversized bow.

## From the Heart ◀

Going for a natural aesthetic? A heart-shaped rattan wreath is a lovely place to start! Layer on dried grasses, palm spears and a sola rose to create a warm, earthy look. Then tuck in mini sola rose picks throughout the wreath to complete the arrangement.
